No. 353 **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE ZONING ORDINANCE CHAPTER 1994-24 No. 365, APPROVED JUNE 27, 1994, AS AMENDED

Approved June 30, 1997

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. The City of Providence Zoning Ordinance Chapter 1994-24 No. 365, Approved June 27, 1994, as amended, shall be further amended as follows:

a) Appendix A, Use Code 84.1, "Manual Assembly of Jewelry, job shops" shall include the following after the words "job shops"

"Manual and machine assisted assembly of jewelry parts; including linking, cutting, looping, but NOT INCLUDING any casting, plating, spot-electric welding (on a Linkomatic type machine) of jewelry parts, open flame soldering or arc welding of such parts. Job shops also include carding, wrapping and packaging of jewelry parts for shipping purposes and may include storage for such parts used in assembly of parts but shall not include bulk storage of any material."

Section 2 This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
