# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 626

Approved October 14, 1994

WHEREAS, Several years ago, after a series of break-ins on the East Side of Providence, and

WHEREAS, Former Councilman Malcolm Farmer was able to get the Narragansett Electric Company to give the area double the luminosity of the regular Street Lights, and

WHEREAS, It was requested that the three poles on Abbotsford Court be increased in order to discourage further crimes there, and

WHEREAS, Indeed, the number of break-ins did decrease, and

WHEREAS, This year on Wednesday, March 30, 1994, the Narragansett Electric Company changed all the lights in the area to a kind of pink tone, and

WHEREAS, We have waited until now to ask the City Council for help because we wanted to see after the leaves on the trees were fully on, if we were getting the same light and we are not, so therefore, we ask if there is any possibility of getting the brighter lights installed again, and

WHEREAS, The Narragansett Electric Company in early April stated that the lights were changed in order "to save money" and however, the security for everyone on the Court has greatly reduced.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Chief Electrical Inspector is hereby ordered to increase the lighting along Abbotsford Court as soon as possible.
