Resolved,

**That** the City Treasurer, acting under the direction of the Committee on Finance, be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to borrow from time to time such sums as may be necessary, not exceeding TWO MILLION (\$2,000,000.00) DOLLARS, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 23 of the Public Laws, passed by the General Assembly at its January Session, A. D. 1958, and approved May 20, 1958, entitled "AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE TO ISSUE BONDS IN THE SUM OF TWO MILLION (\$2,000,000.00) DOLLARS FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES", and to issue the City's notes therefor, signed by him and countersigned by the Mayor and Chairman of Finance Committee; and to renew any such notes from time to time as the same become due. The money thus obtained is hereby appropriated for and shall be exclusively used and expended for the purchase of land for public school purposes and/or the construction, furnishing and equipping of public school buildings in said City.
