Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, March 10, 1953.

This referral is a request for a change in zoning from an R-4 Zone to a C-4 Zone Lot 584 on Assessor's Plat 37, containing 6,279 square feet of land area.


The property in question is located on the northeasterly corner of the intersection of Huntington Avenue and Rosedale Street, and is presently occupied by a three-family structure.

A similar request was considered by the Commission in Referral No. 406 in April of 1952, at which time the Commission's recommendation for denial was upheld. Because of the detrimental nature to the adjacent neighborhood area and the establishment of any additional business would further contribute to traffic congestion on Huntington Avenue, which is already exceeding its traffic capacity,

VOTED: To recommend to the Committee on Ordinances that this petition be denied.

PETITION OF JOHN RAO to change the rear portion of Lot 8 as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 70 from a Residential R-3 Zone to a Commercial C-2 Zone, said lot being located on the easterly side of Douglas Avenue and designated as 583 Douglas Avenue.






