In accordance with the Provisions of Section 406 of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980, as amended and Rule 3 of the Rules of the City Council, I am, this day, calling a Special Meeting of the City Council to be held on Thursday, June 22, 2023 at 4:30 o'clock P.M., in the City Council Chamber, Third Floor, City Hall, for the purpose of acting upon the following:

An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 220 of Chapter 2022-27, Adopted June 24, 2022, providing for the Assessment and Collection of 2022 Taxes in a sum not less than Three Hundred Sixty Five Million Nine Hundred Forty Five Thousand and One Hundred and Seventy Six Dollars (\$365,945,176) and not more than Three Hundred Seventy Seven Million Forty Five Thousand and Three Hundred and Forty Two Dollars (\$377,045,342) being One Hundred Percent (100%) of the 2022-2023 Fiscal Year Tax Collections, and Setting the Rates for Fiscal Year 2024.
