No. 537 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THE ELECTION OF AUCTIONEERS AND ESTABLISHING THE FEE FOR THE LICENSE AND COMMISSION FOR THE SAME.

Approved December 23, 1966

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The City Council shall elect on the first Monday in January, quadrennially, commencing A. D. 1967 one or more auctioneers.

SECTION 2. The fee for license and commission as auctioneer is hereby established and fixed in the amount of \$200.00.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

RESOLVED,

That the Olneyville Business Men's Association be granted the privilege of erecting light decorations and related Christmas decorations for the 1966 Christmas Season along and over and across certain streets as may be incorporated in said Association's plans, all subject to the approval of the Director of Public Works and the Public Service Engineer; provided that the Olneyville Business Men's Association shall furnish to the City and file with the City Clerk, prior to the erection of any of the foregoing, a liability insurance policy certificate, approved as to form by the City Solicitor, its limits to be not less than One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) Dollars and Three Hundred Thousand (\$300,000.00) Dollars in public liability and Twenty-five Thousand (\$25,000.00) Dollars property damage, indemnifying the City against any claim arising out of any damage due to the erection, maintenance and/or removal of any decorations or parts thereof.




