Approved April 10, 1986

WHEREAS, The intersection of Elmgrove Avenue and Sessions Street presently has a blinking yellow light but is the location of a large number of automobile accidents, and

WHEREAS, Said intersection is traversed daily by students of the Hebrew Day School, the Solomon Schechter Day School at Temple Emmanuel, Nathan Bishop School and participants in the many programs run by the Jewish Community Center,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer undertake a study of the traffic conditions at said intersection with the aim of determining whether a stop and go red and green light should be located at said intersection for the safety of motorists and pedestrians in said area.

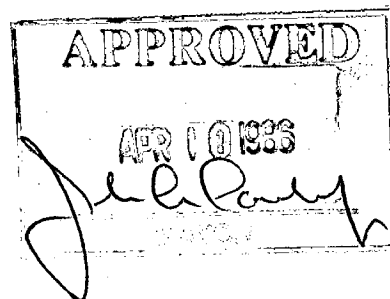
