
WHEREAS, House Bill 90-H4146, presently pending before the Committee on Corporations, relates to the State Building Code - Hazardous Buildings, and




NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the members of the Providence City Council hereby endorse House Bill 90-H4146.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 23-27.3-125.5 of the General Laws in Chapter  
2 23-27.3 entitled "State Building Code" is hereby amended to read as  
3 follows:

4 23-27.3-125.5. Hazardous buildings. -- Whenever a building is in  
5 such hazardous condition as to create an immediate danger to the  
6 public health, safety, and welfare, either because of its potential as  
7 a fire hazard or because of the danger from collapse, the building  
8 official may board up the building immediately at the owner's expense  
9 and may order its immediate demolition. In the event that the owner  
10 fails to comply immediately with the order, to demolish then the  
11 building official may demolish the dwelling building at the expense of  
12 the owner.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
