



SUBJECT: Four-Way Stop – George St and Hope St

In response to a request, an investigation was made of the intersection of George Street and Hope Street.

Due to the significant number of accidents at this location, it was found that the intersection meet Guidance B. under Section 2B.07 Multiway Stop Applications of the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices, in that there were 5 or more reported crashes in a 12-month period.

It is the intention of the Traffic Engineering Division to install four-way stop signs at this location.
