CAMP STREET, beginning at a point of the intersection of the centerline of Camp Street and the northerly line of Olney Street and running northerly two hundred sixty one and 02/100 (261.02) feet more or less to a point at the intersection of the centerline of Camp Street and a prolongation of the southerly line of Carrington Avenue, be abandoned.

LEGG STREET, from DePinedo Street to its southerly termination, be abandoned.

ARGOL STREET, from Edgeworth Avenue northerly to the City Line; grade be defined; establish as a public highway; bring to the established or defined grade; curbing be set at the expense of the abutting owners.

DOMESTIC STREET, from Oakland Avenue to Malbone Street; declare and establish as a public highway; bring to the established or defined grade; curbing be set at the expense of the abutting owners.

MYSTIC STREET, from Prairie Avenue to its easterly termination; grade be defined; establish as a public highway; bring to the established or defined grade; curbing be set at the expense of the abutting owners.
