No. 1000 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 544 OF 1951, BY CHANGING FROM AN R-3 GENERAL RESIDENCE ZONE TO A C-4 HEAVY COMMERCIAL ZONE, LOT 14, AS SET OUT AND DELINEATED ON CITY ASSESSOR'S PLAT 42; SAID LOT BEING LOCATED AT 765 CRANSTON STREET.

Approved May 24, 1968

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended, and entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height and Area Regulations", is hereby further amended by changing from an R-3 General Residence Zone to a C-4 Heavy Commercial Zone, Lot 14, as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 42; said lot being located at 765 Cranston Street, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the northerly line of Cranston Street at the southeasterly corner of Lot 14 on Assessor's Plat 42; thence westerly along the northerly line of Cranston Street to the southwesterly corner of Lot 14; thence northerly along the easterly lines of Lots 78 and 344 (said lines also being the Zoning Division Line between the present R-3 General Residence Zone and the present C-4 Heavy Commercial Zone) to the northwesterly corner of Lot 14; thence easterly along the southerly line of Lot 43 to the northeasterly corner of Lot 14; thence southerly along the westerly lines of Lots 404 and 405 to the northerly line of Cranston Street at the southeasterly corner of Lot 14 and the point and place of beginning.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

SUBJECT: Referral No. 1666 - ZONING CHANGE AT 765 CRANSTON STREET

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, February 27, 1968.

This referral is a petition to change the zoning of Lot 14, Assessor's Plat 42 at 765 Cranston Street from R-3 (general residence zone) to C-4 (heavy commercial zone).


On an inspection and photographic survey it was determined that Lot 14 contains a 2½-story frame dwelling in fair condition. The surrounding neighborhood is mixed residential and commercial and in poor condition.

This property has a C-4 Zone abutting it on its westerly side and a C-2 Zone just one lot away on its easterly side. The strip of land on each side of this portion of Cranston Street is poorly suited for residential use. The dwellings still remaining are approaching dilapidated condition and even the commercial buildings are badly run-down.

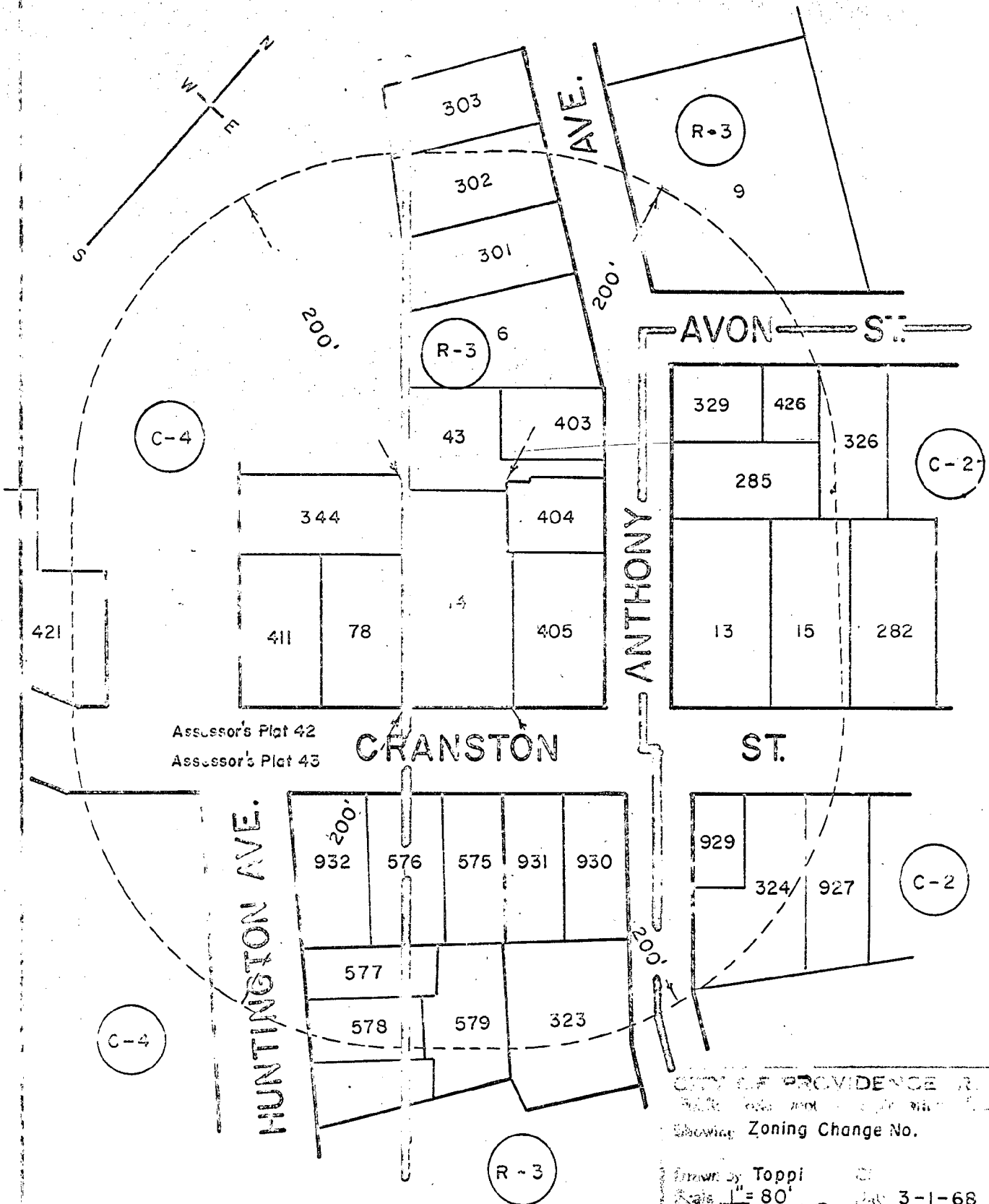
