ELECTION OF THREE PROVIDENCE MUNICIPAL COURT JUSTICES

COUNCIL PRESIDENT FARGNOLI calls for nominations for Three Justices of the Providence Municipal Court.

The several nominations are seconded by COUNCIL PRESIDENT FARGNOLI and COUNCILMEN ALMAGNO, BOYLE, COUNCILWOMAN BRASSIL, COUNCILMEN CIRELLI, COLA, DILLON, EASTON, FARMER, FLYNN, GLAVIN, JOHNSON, LYNCH, MANSOLILLO, MOISE, O'CONNOR, PAOLINO, PEARLMAN, PENNINE PETROSINELLI, SALVATORE, SNOWDEN, STRAVATO and XAVIER.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT FARGNOLI calls for further nominations and there being none, on motion of COUNCILMAN ADDISON, seconded by COUNCILMEN GLAVIN, FLYNN and MOISE, it is voted that nominations be closed.

On motion of COUNCILMAN ADDISON, seconded by COUNCILMAN FLYNN, GLAVIN and ALMAGNO, the Clerk is directed to cast one ballot for EDWARD F. MALLOY, ESQUIRE, of Providence; JOHN P. GARAN, ESQUIRE, of Providence; and EDWARD C. CLIFTON, ESQUIRE, of Providence.

The Clerk casts one ballot for each as directed.

COUNCIL PRESIDENT FARGNOLI thereupon declares EDWARD F. MALLOY, ESQUIRE, JOHN P. GARAN, ESQUIRE and EDWARD C. CLIFTON, ESQUIRE, duly elected as Justices of the Providence Municipal Court for the ensuing term of Two Years ending on the First Monday in January, 1983.
