

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 513

Approved August 10, 1978

WHEREAS, "Dave" Gavitt, Providence College Basketball Coach, was selected as coach of the United States of America's Olympic Team for the games scheduled to be played in Moscow, 1980, and

WHEREAS, Successful and popular, "Dave" was selected unanimously by the American Basketball Association Games Committee, the same to be approved by the Executive Board of this Nation of which approval is virtually assured, and

WHEREAS, The honor of such a calling affords the popular "Dave" an opportunity to demonstrate to sports followers his proven ability to mold into a well coordinated aggregation, the best basketball team to represent our Nation in Moscow,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That to "Dave" Gavitt, basketball coach, "par-excellance" the sincere best wishes of the City Council of Providence is extended that he emerge from the 1980 Olympics victoriously and that he further present to all the participating Nations, in Moscow, his quality to display the personality of Providence's gift to the 1980 Olympic Games.
