In accordance with the Provisions of Section 406 of the Providence Home Rule Charter of 1980, As Amended and Rule 3 of the Rules of the City Council, I am, this day, calling a Special Meeting of the City Council to be held on Wednesday, August 3, 2022 at 5:00 o'clock P.M., in the City Council Chamber, Third Floor, City Hall, for the purpose of acting upon the following:

Presentation given by the Administration and the Rhode Island Department of Education relative to the \$125,000,000.00 Bond Ballot question.

Resolution Memorializing the General Assembly to enact legislation authorizing the City of Providence, with approval of qualified electors, to issue not to exceed \$125,000,000.00 General Obligation Bonds, Notes and other Evidences of Indebtedness to Finance the Construction, Renovation, Improvement, Alteration, Repair, Landscaping, Furnishing and Equipping of schools and school facilities throughout the City, subject to approval of State Housing Aid at a reimbursement rate or State Share Ratio of not less than 75% at the time of issuance and provided that the authorization shall be reduced by the amount of certain grants received from state bond proceeds, from the Rhode Island Department of Education or from the Rhode Island School Building Authority.
