Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, June 8, 1954.

This referral is a request for the abandonment of a portion of Homer Street running from Cactus Street southerly to Roger Williams Park.


On the field trip it was found that the area in question is at present uncurbed and unpaved and dead-ends at Roger Williams Park.

Recognizing the beautiful landscape and the large gracious trees lying in the park area the extension of Homer Street would not be feasible as it is not essential to the street system in the immediate neighborhood, and there are presently too many streets entering Roger Williams Park.

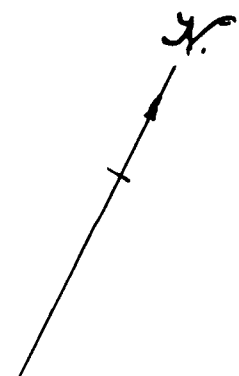

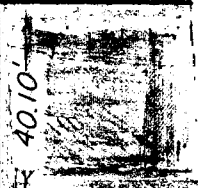
