We have completed our investigation of the intersection of Niagara Street and Warrington Street. Our study showed low volumes of traffic on both of these streets. In addition the accident record for this location is good. Our records show only six reported accidents in the last four years. Therefore we do not recommend the installation of "STOP" or "YIELD" control at this intersection.
