The Traffic Engineering Department has received the following resolution from your Committee and has taken the subsequent action:

Request: That the traffic engineer is requested to cause traffic guide lines to be painted along Francis Street, from Smith Street to Gaspee Street and crosswalks on Francis Street, in the immediate vicinity of the State House.

Disposition: Our street painting program will not begin until the end of April. At the present time, all of our equipment has been dismantled for repair and cleaning. In addition, street line paint will not dry properly if the ground temperature is below 40 degrees.
