RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 45

Approved February 12, 1982

WHEREAS, In December of 1981, Congress approved a \$569 Million Amtrack subsidy which included a proviso forbidding the railroad to use its money to pay local or state taxes, and

WHEREAS, This congressional action will cost the City of Providence to lose \$581,000 in tax revenue, notwithstanding other communities in our State, who will lose thousands of dollars,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the City of Providence is hereby requested to join with other Municipalities in taking legal action to rectify the non-payment of taxes by Amtrack, which has been legislated by Congress.
