ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice to be published in a newspaper, published in the County of Providence, at least once each week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting upon that portion of Santiago Street from Alexander Street to its westerly termination, which have been abandoned, who is know to reside within this State.

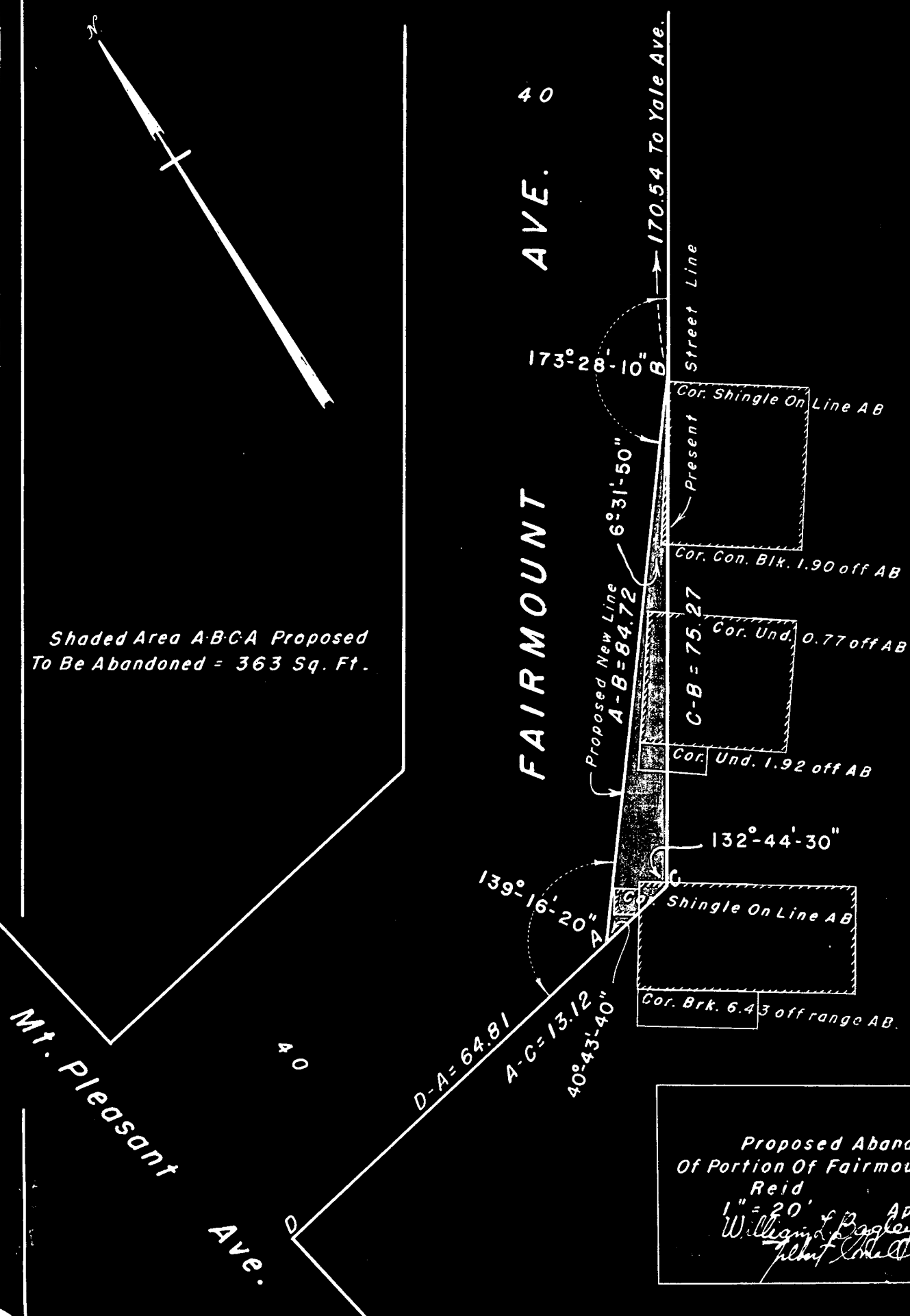
