# RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 364

Approved July 19, 1976

WHEREAS, the Providence Lodge No. 3, Fraternal Order of Police, has contracted to underwrite the entire cost of the ensuing 43rd National Conference of the Fraternal Order of Police, scheduled to be held in the City of Providence, during the period August 7 to August 12, 1977; inclusive, and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget for adequate planning and presentation of that conference is the sole responsibility of the Providence Lodge No. 3, Fraternal Order of Police, as the host Lodge, and

WHEREAS, in order to assist in the raising of funds for the proposed National Conference in Providence, the host Lodge is scheduling the "Mayor's Summer Festival, Sponsored by the State Lodge, Fraternal Order of Police Convention Committee", during the period of August 15, 1976 to August 22, 1976; inclusive, in Downtown Providence,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in keeping with the spirit and intent of the proposed Summer Festival, the Traffic Engineer is hereby requested to prohibit Motor Vehicle Traffic along the northerly side of Kennedy Plaza, from Exchange Street, and Exchange Terrace to Dorrance Street, during the period of August 15 to August 22, 1976; inclusive, to Accommodate that Festival.
