Approved August 30, 1975

WHEREAS, Traffic Directional Overhead Signs over and across the Dennis J. Roberts Expressway, are in a state of disrepair, which create a traffic hazard and further are in dire need of refurbishing, and

WHEREAS, Guide Lines are in need of repainting and Guard Rails are in need of repair, and

WHEREAS, the general condition of the expressway, per se needs grooming.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the State Director of the Department of Transportation is requested to cause the refurbishing of all traffic signs; cause illumination to be repaired; replace all damaged or missing guard rails and repaint guide lines along the Dennis J. Roberts Expressway.

Reference is made to your letter to Mr. Rahill regarding conditions on the Dennis J. Roberts Expressway.

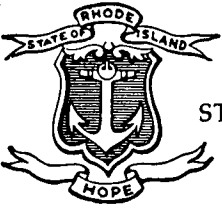
Please be advised that I have turned this matter over to Mr. Matthew J. Kulick, Chief of the Maintenance Division, for his investigation and corrective action.
