RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 760

Approved December 29, 1978

Resolution approving the accompanying plats (Map 1 of 3, Map 2 of 3 and Map 3 of 3) entitled Dedication of Cranston Street (Widening), West Broadway Project A2-1, Providence Redevelopment Agency, Stanley P. Blacher, Chairman, et al, Scale 1"=40.00', dedicating for highway purposes certain tracts or parcels of land shown as cross-hatched areas and designated by the letters A-B-C-A, D-E-G-F-D, and H-J-K-L-H, and including as part of Cranston Street the areas designated by the letters B-C-D-E-B (formerly part of Harrison Street), and F-G-J-H-F (formerly part of Hammond Street), on the accompanying plans under the provisions of Chapter 987 of the Public Laws of 1913, and thereafter declared a public highway to be repaired and maintained at the expense of the City of Providence.

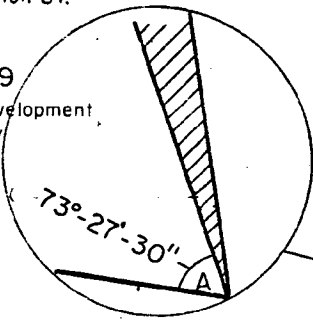

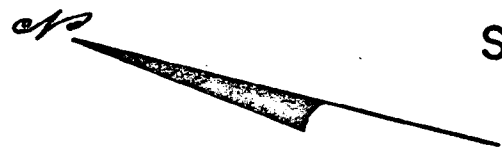

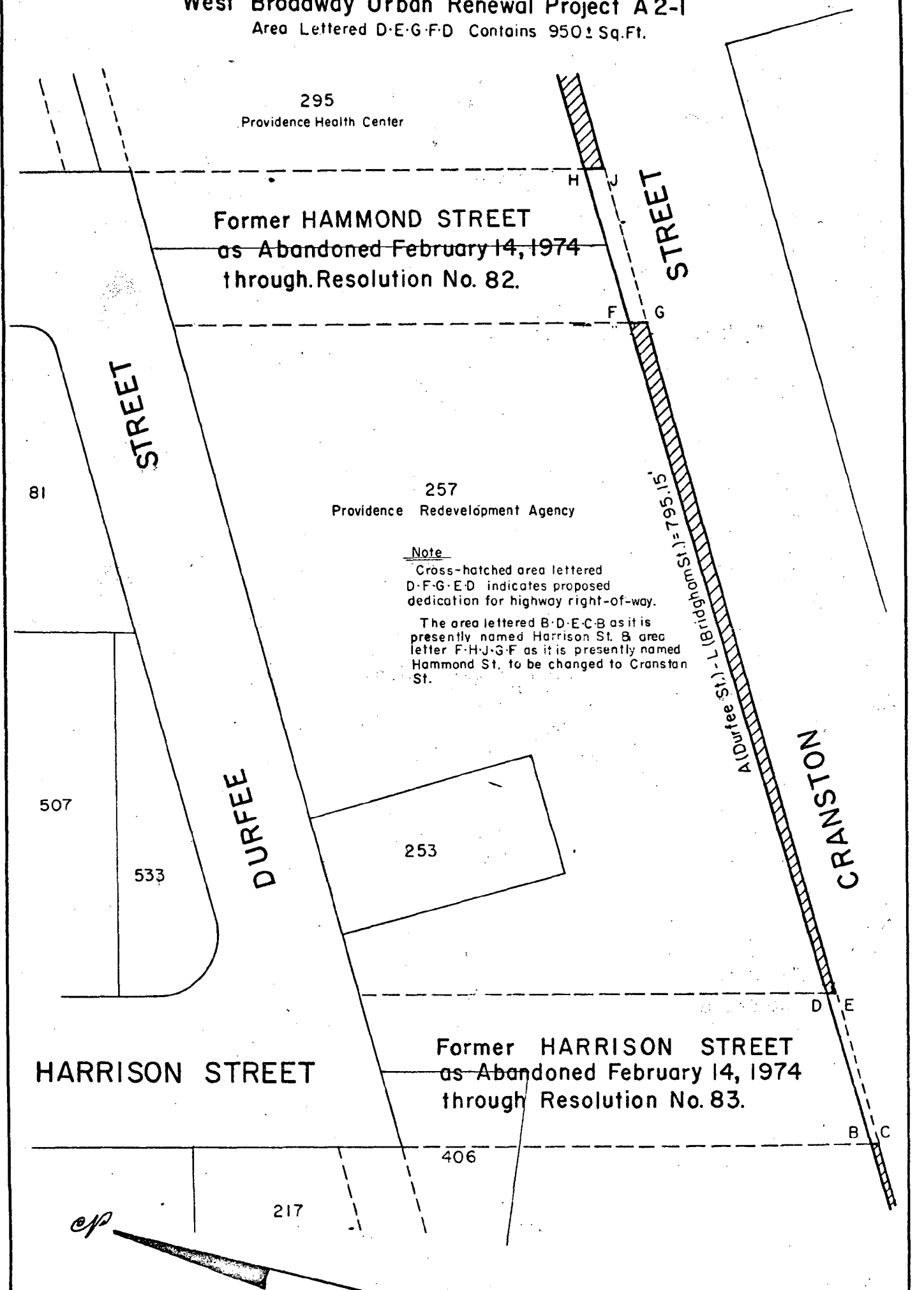
