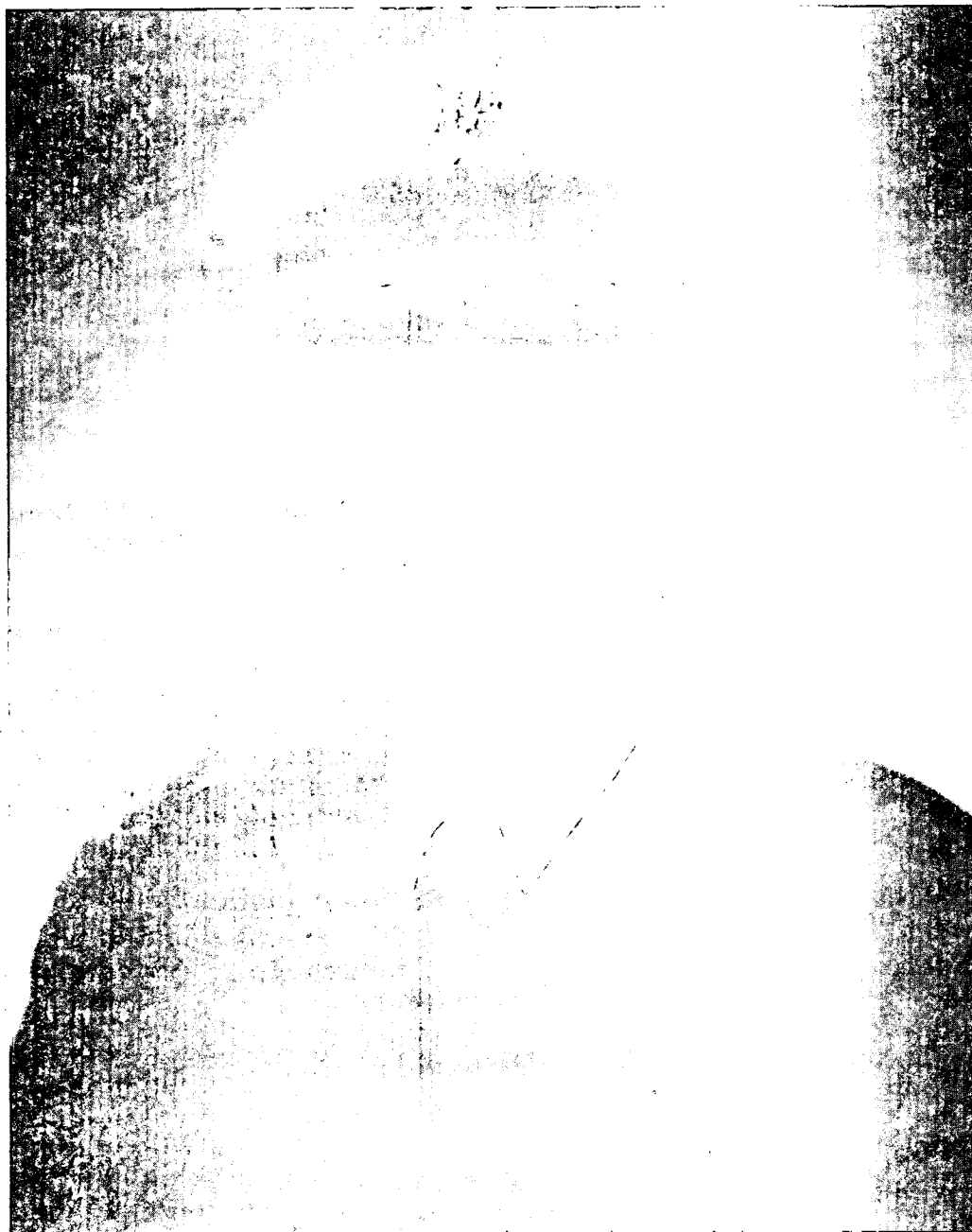

Dear Mayor:

I hereby respectfully submit the 1974 Annual Statistical Report, illustrating the police department's operational activities and accomplishments for the year.

For the third time in as many years, Providence in 1974 experienced a decrease of serious crimes compared with the preceding calendar year. The percentage decrease was .56% which some people will view as a small figure. I believe this figure looms large when compared with increases of 17% nationally, 15% for the Northeast and other cities in our population class, with 21% in other larger New England cities, and the increase of almost 5% for the State of Rhode Island.


The .56% decrease is representative of all Part I crimes (serious crimes) and certainly we can derive some satisfaction from this statistic as we look at the increases elsewhere. But I think we can derive more satisfaction from the fact that in "crimes against persons" category, the most hideous of all crimes, the decrease was 13%. (Offenses classified as "crimes against property" totaled approximately the same number as 1973.)

Although there are many causative factors of crimes against persons and property over which the police department has little control, our officers and civilian employees dedicate themselves to making the City of Providence as safe as possible for all citizens.

During 1975, your first year as the chief executive officer of the city government, this department looks forward to your administrative leadership, support and understanding for the programs and problems that will unfold during the year.

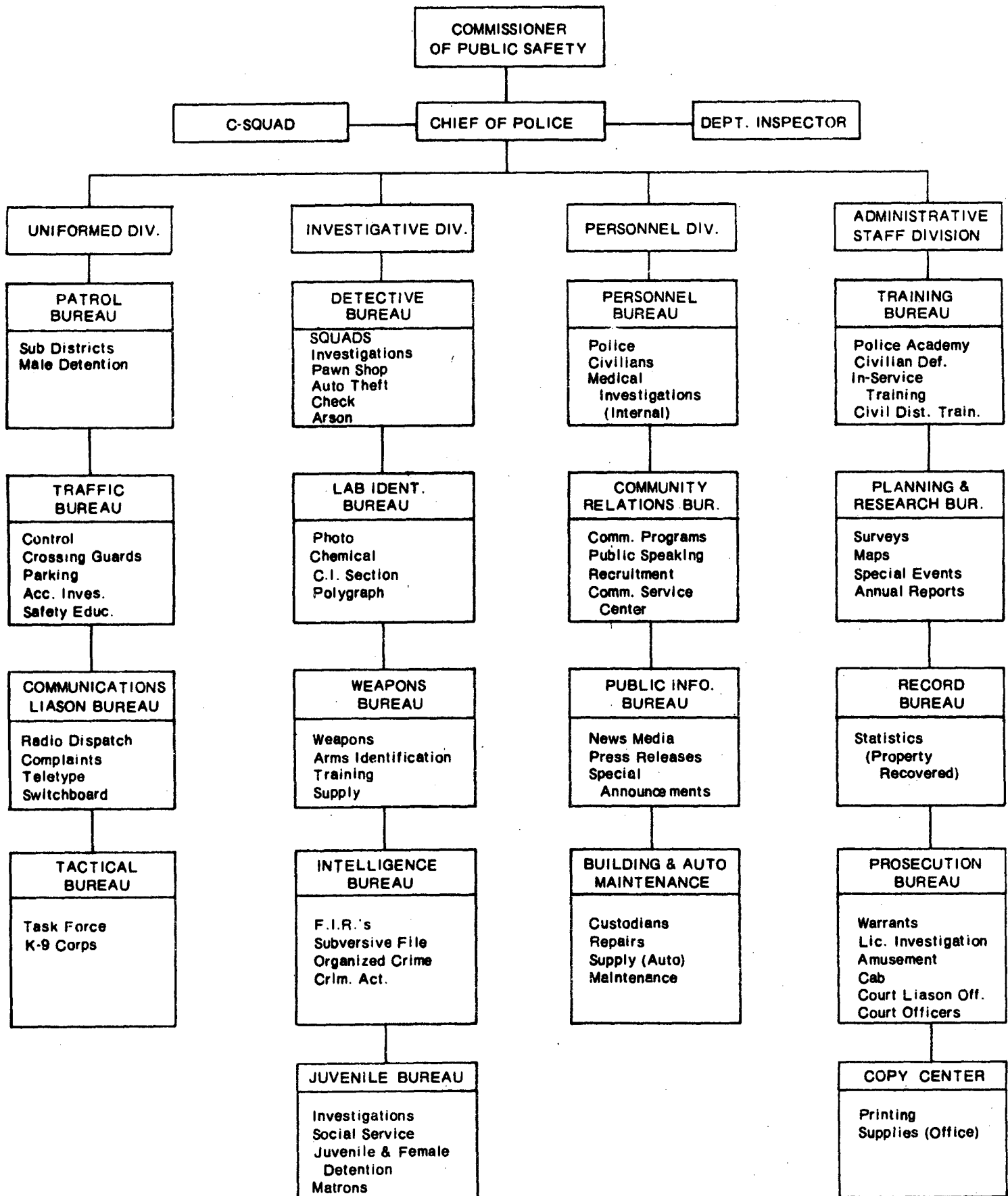

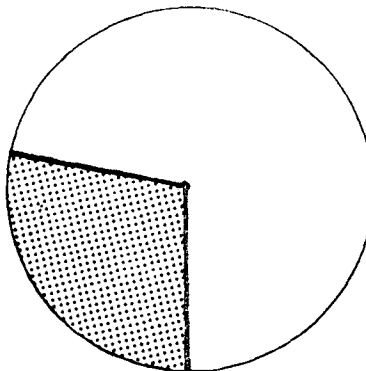
CLEARANCE OF PART I OFFENSES REPORTED TO THE POLICE

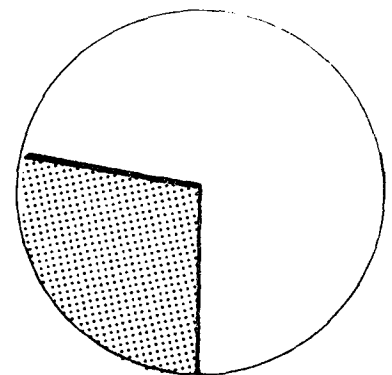

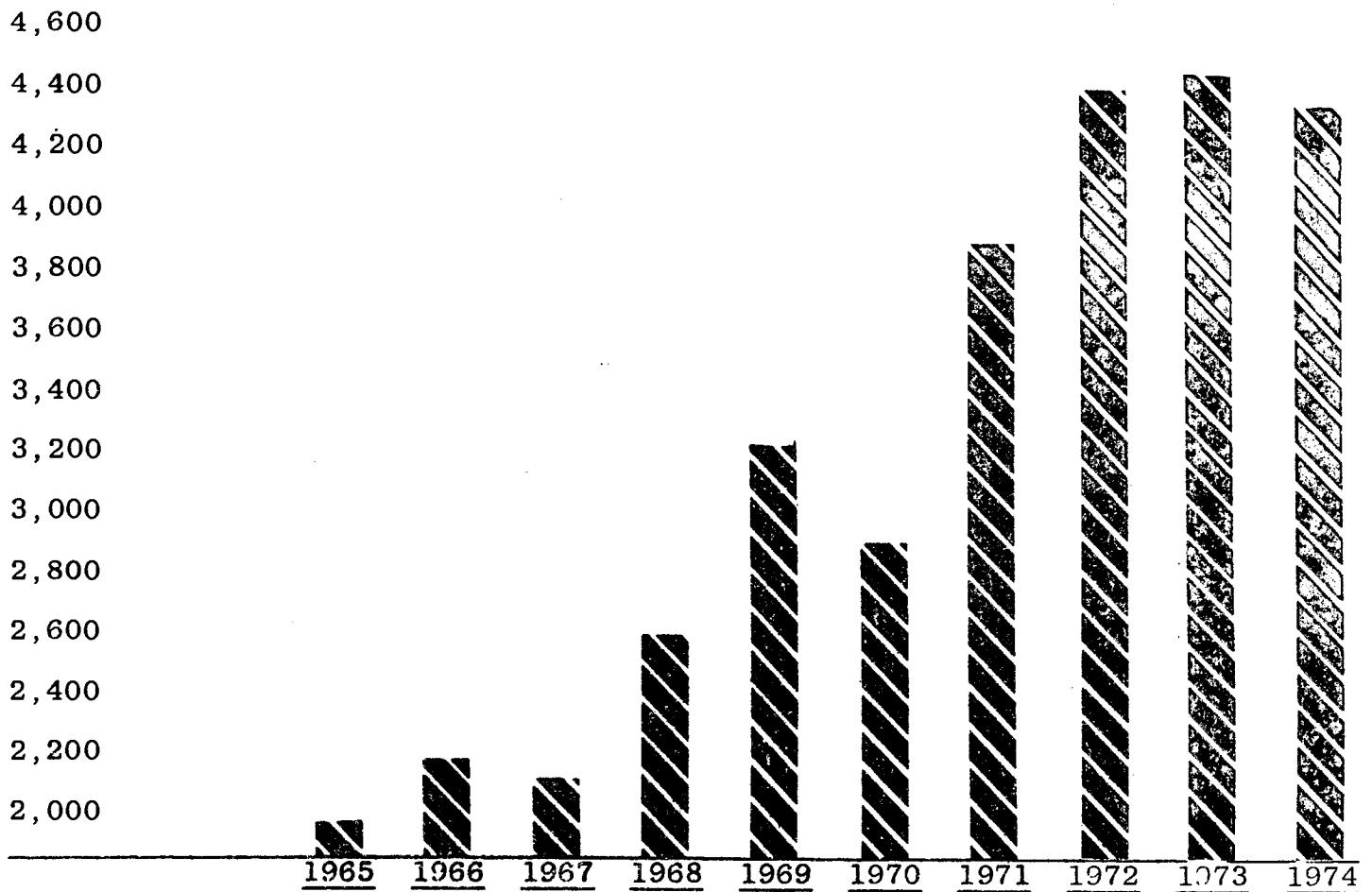

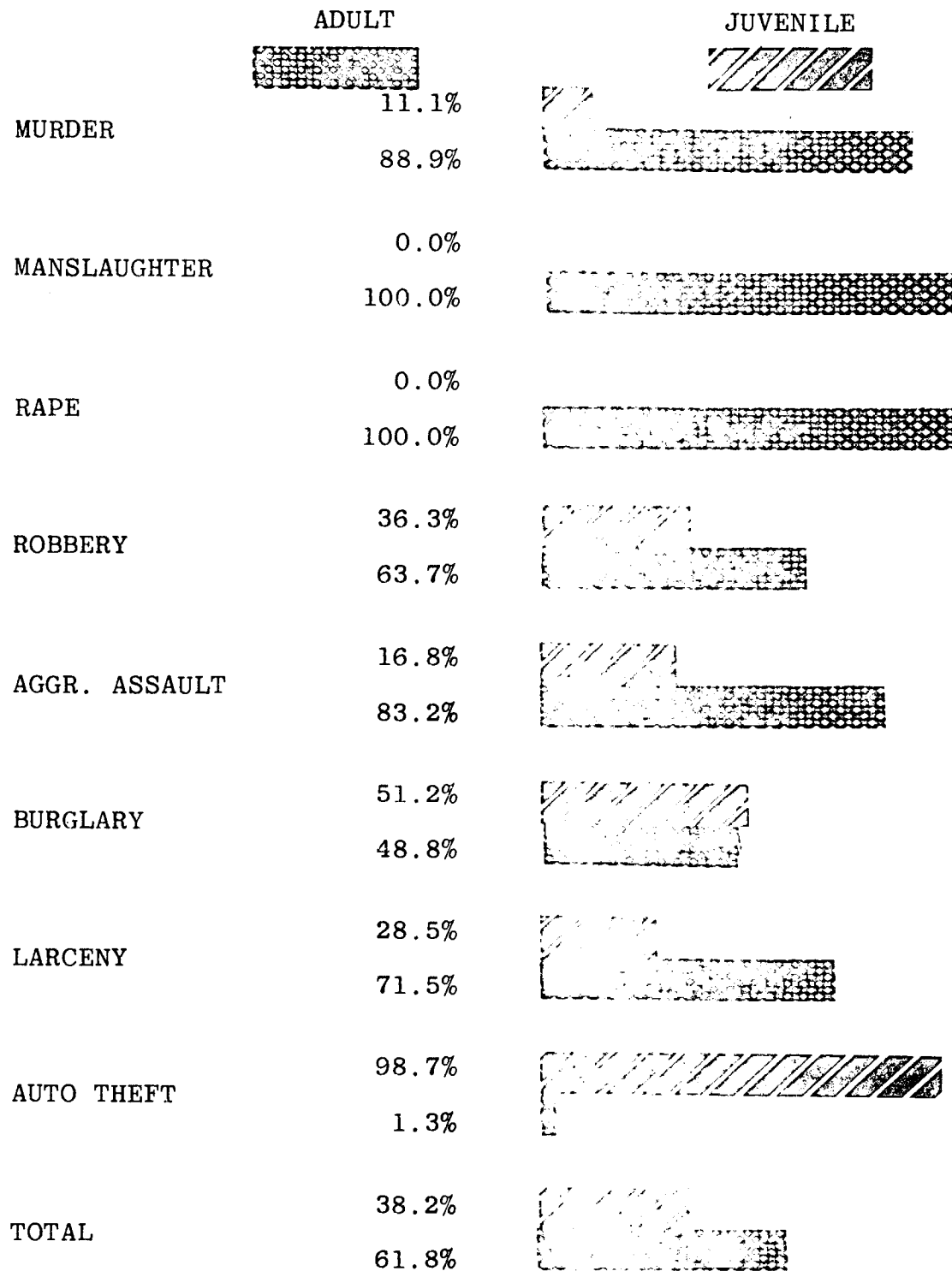

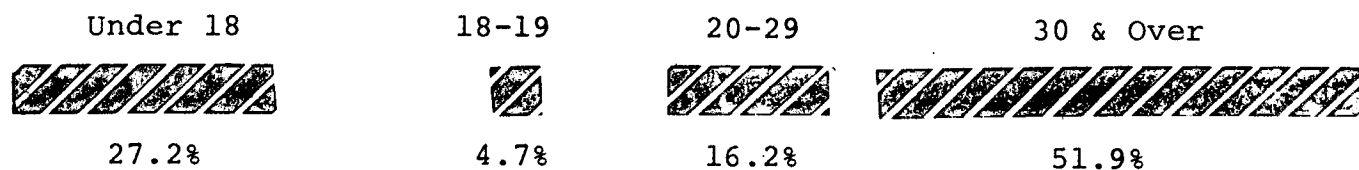

ADULT-JUVENILE ARRESTS FOR PART I OFFENSES IN PROVIDENCE FOR 1974

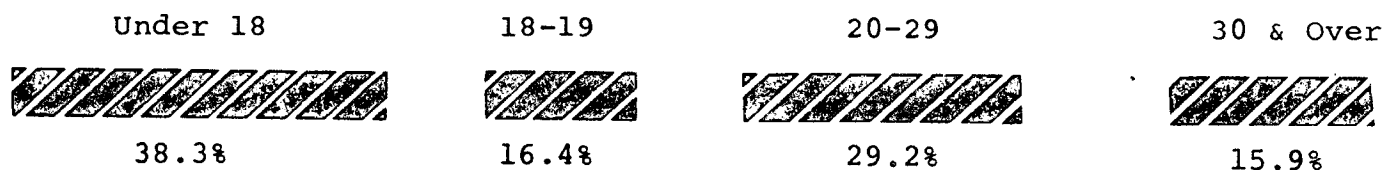


COMPARISON OF POPULATION AGE GROUPS TO ARREST AGE GROUPS

PROVIDENCE POPULATION BY AGE GROUPS*



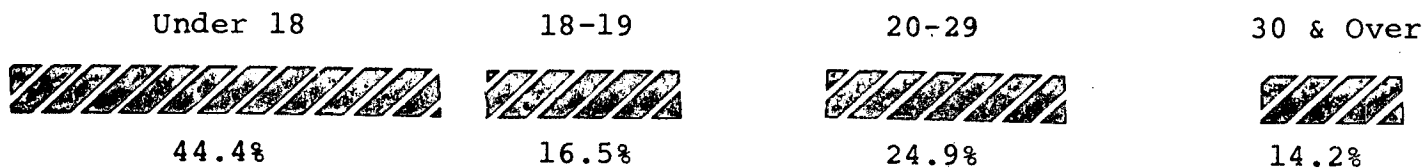
PERSONS ARRESTED FOR PART I OFFENSES
