SUBJECT: Referral No. 1105 - ZONING CHANGE AT BURRINGTON STREET, VICINITY OF PLEASANT VIEW AVENUE AND HAMBURG AVENUE

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, September 8, 1959.

This referral is a request to change from an R-3 Zone to an M-1 Zone Lots 362, 364, 365, 366, 367, 615, 614, 613, 612, 568 and 569 on City Assessor's Plat 50; said lots of land being situated on the southerly side of Burrington Street and in the vicinity of Pleasant View Avenue and Hamburg Avenue. The area in question contains 54,400 square feet of land.

On an inspection survey it was found that one portion of the property in question is occupied by a one-story industrial building and the remaining lots of land were undeveloped.


Reference is made to Referral No. 820, from the Committee on Ordinances, dated June 12, 1956 at which time a similar request was submitted. At that time the City Plan Commission recommended a denial of the petition and the denial was upheld by the City Council.

The Providence Redevelopment Agency has defined the Mashapaug Redevelopment Project and the property in question is included in the Research Study. Until definite plans for the Mashapaug area have been completed and adopted,
