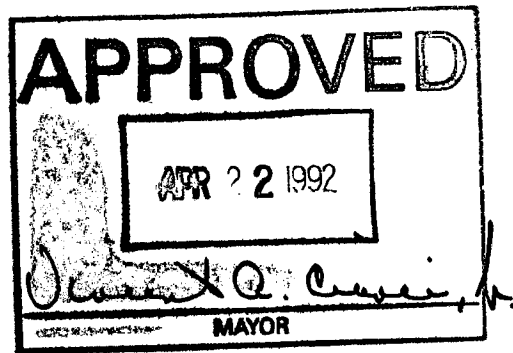

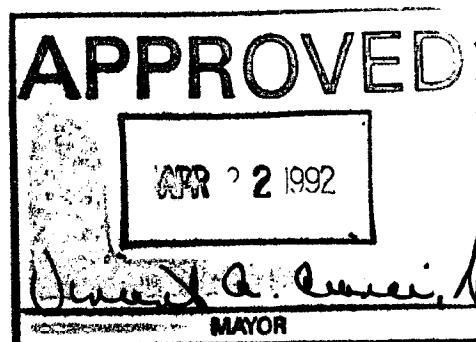

the intersection)
East side of Willow Street, 20 feet north of Messer Street
South side of Parade Street, 10 feet west of Hudson Street
East side of Hudson Street, 20 feet south of Sycamore Street
Two (2) at the northwest corner of Messer and Hudson Streets
One (1) at the northeast corner of Messer and Hudson Streets
Southeast corner of Wood and Messer Streets
Northeast and northwest corners of Wood and Sycamore Streets
Southeast and southwest corners of Wood and Parade Streets
All Three (3) at the corner of Sycamore Street and Chapin Avenue
Both east and west sides of Chapin Avenue, 10 feet north of
Messer Street
Southwest corner of Chapin Avenue and Messer Street
Vicinity of Cowper Court and Messer Street
Northeast corner of Superior and Cranston Streets
Southwest corner of Cranston and Wendell Streets
