RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 469

Approved November 12, 1969

WHEREAS, Chapter 174 of the Public Laws of 1964, known as "The Green Acres Land Acquisition Act of 1964, as amended", provides for the making of grants by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources to bodies to assist them in the acquisition of permanent interests in land for recreation-conservation purposes where such acquisition is deemed essential to the proper long-range development and welfare of the local unit in accordance with a comprehensive plan for the development of the local unit; and

WHEREAS, The City of Providence, desires to acquire certain land known as King Philip Street Tot Lot, which land is to be held and used for permanent recreation or conservation land as a Tot Lot; and

WHEREAS, It is estimated that the total consideration to be paid for the acquisition of said land will be \$7000;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PROVIDENCE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the application be made to the Director of the Department of Natural Resources for a grant in an amount authorized by "The Green Acres Land Acquisition Act of 1964, as amended" of the State of Rhode Island, which amount is equal to 50% of the price to be paid for the acquisition of the land and which amount is presently estimated to be \$3,500 and that the City of Providence will pay the balance of the consideration for the acquisition of such land and the total of all related costs out of the funds available to it.
2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file such application with the Director of the Department of Natural Resources; to provide additional information and furnish such documents as may be required; to execute such contracts as are required; and to act as the authorized correspondent of the City of Providence.
3. That the proposed acquisition is in accordance with the Master Plan for Public Recreation and Conservation for the provision of recreation or conservation land, and that, should said grant be made, the City of Providence will retain said land for use designated in said application and approved by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources.

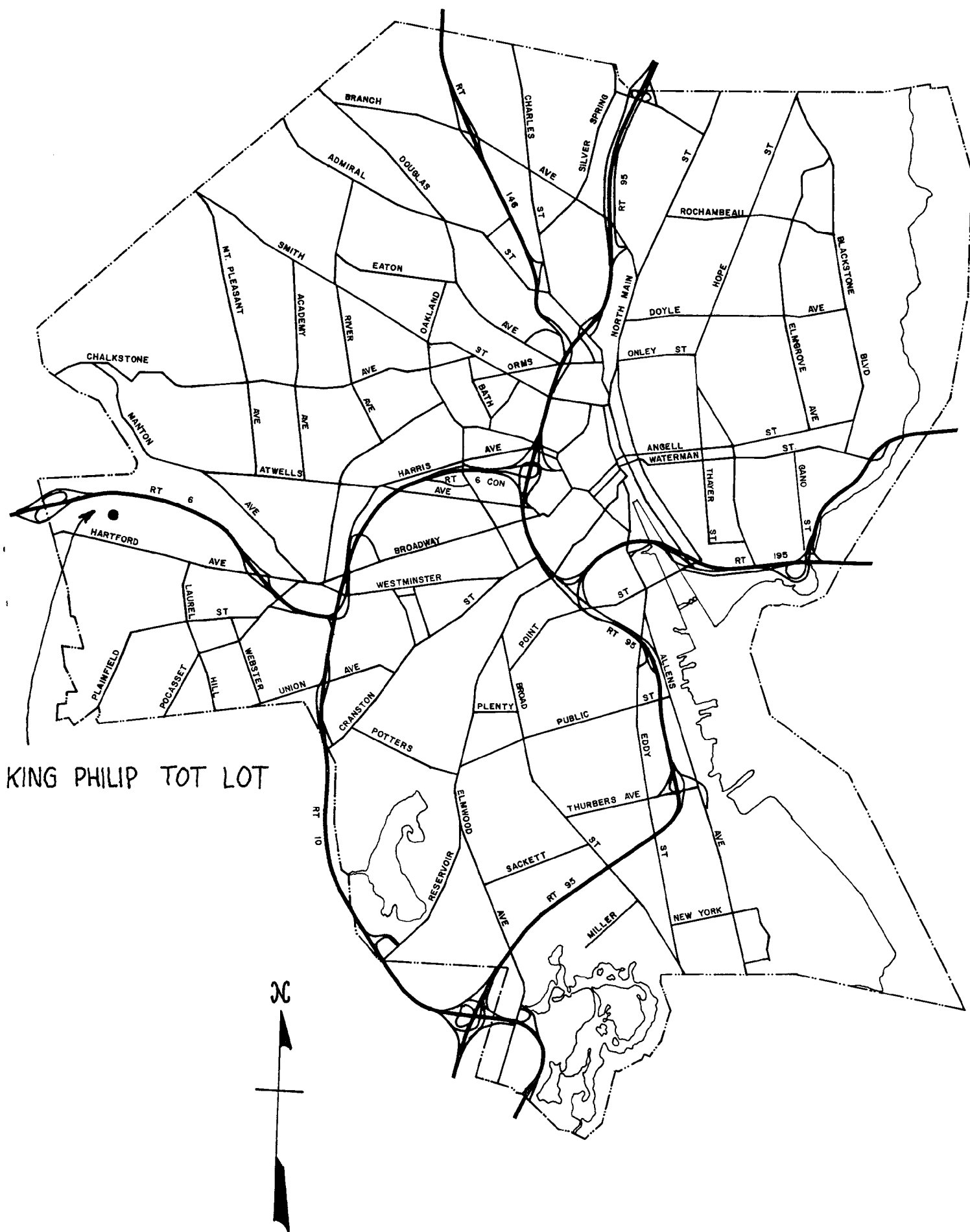

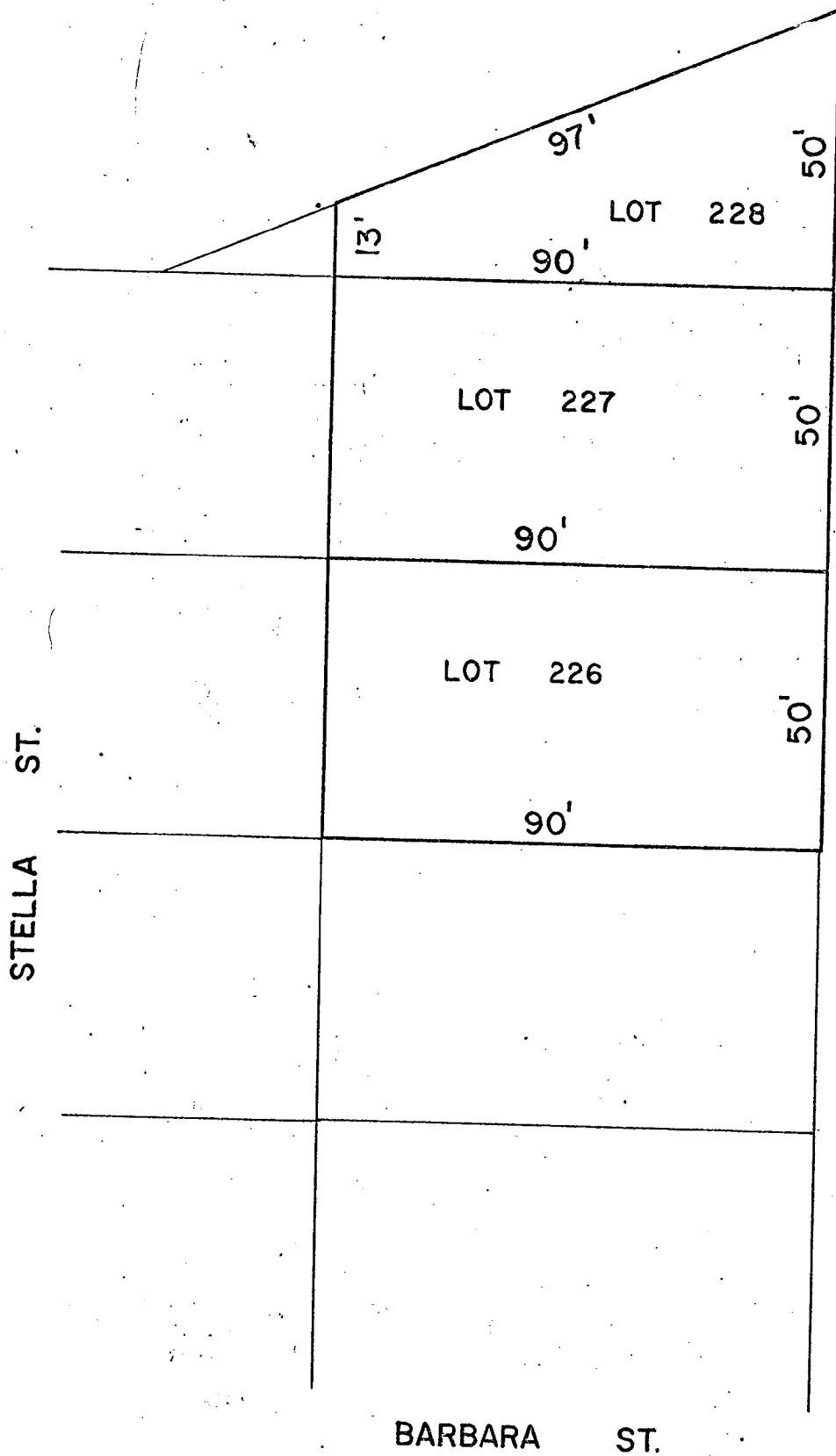

WHEREAS, The City of Providence, desires to acquire certain land known as Vermont Avenue Tot Lot, which land is to be held and used for permanent recreation or conservation land as a Tot Lot; and

WHEREAS, It is estimated that the total consideration to be paid for the acquisition of said land will be \$3,240;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF PROVIDENCE AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the application be made to the Director of the Department of Natural Resources for a grant in an amount authorized by "The Green Acres Land Acquisition Act of 1964, as amended" of the State of Rhode Island, which amount is equal to 50% of the price to be paid for the acquisition of the land and which amount is presently estimated to be \$1,620 and that the City of Providence will pay the balance of the consideration for the acquisition of such land and the total of all related costs out of the funds available to it.
2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file such application with the Director of the Department of Natural Resources; to provide additional information and furnish such documents as may be required; to execute such contracts as are required; and to act as the authorized correspondent of the City of Providence.
3. That the proposed acquisition is in accordance with the Master Plan for Public Recreation and Conservation for the provision of recreation on conservation land, and that, should said grant be made, the City of Providence will retain said land for use designated in said application and approved by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources.

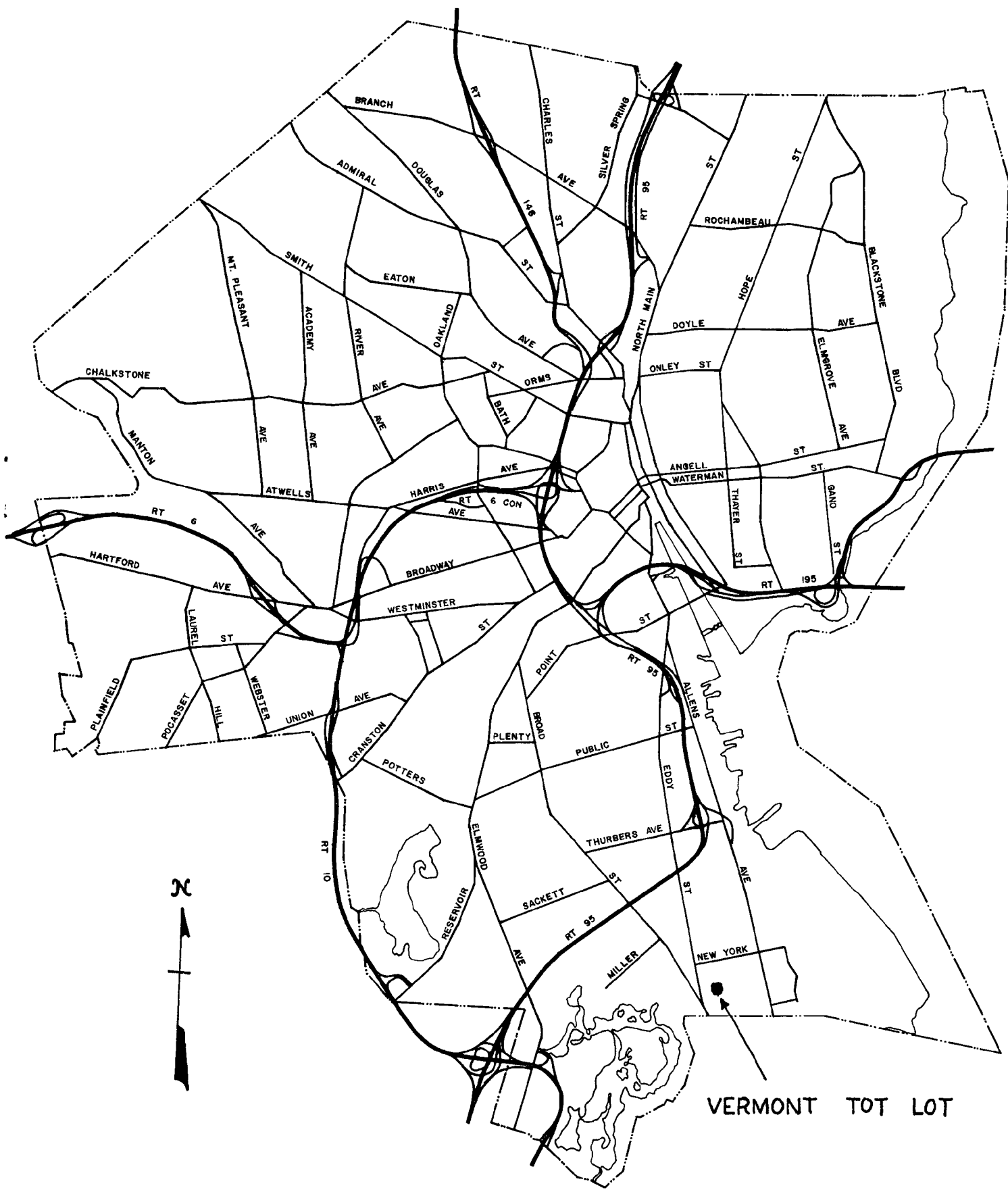

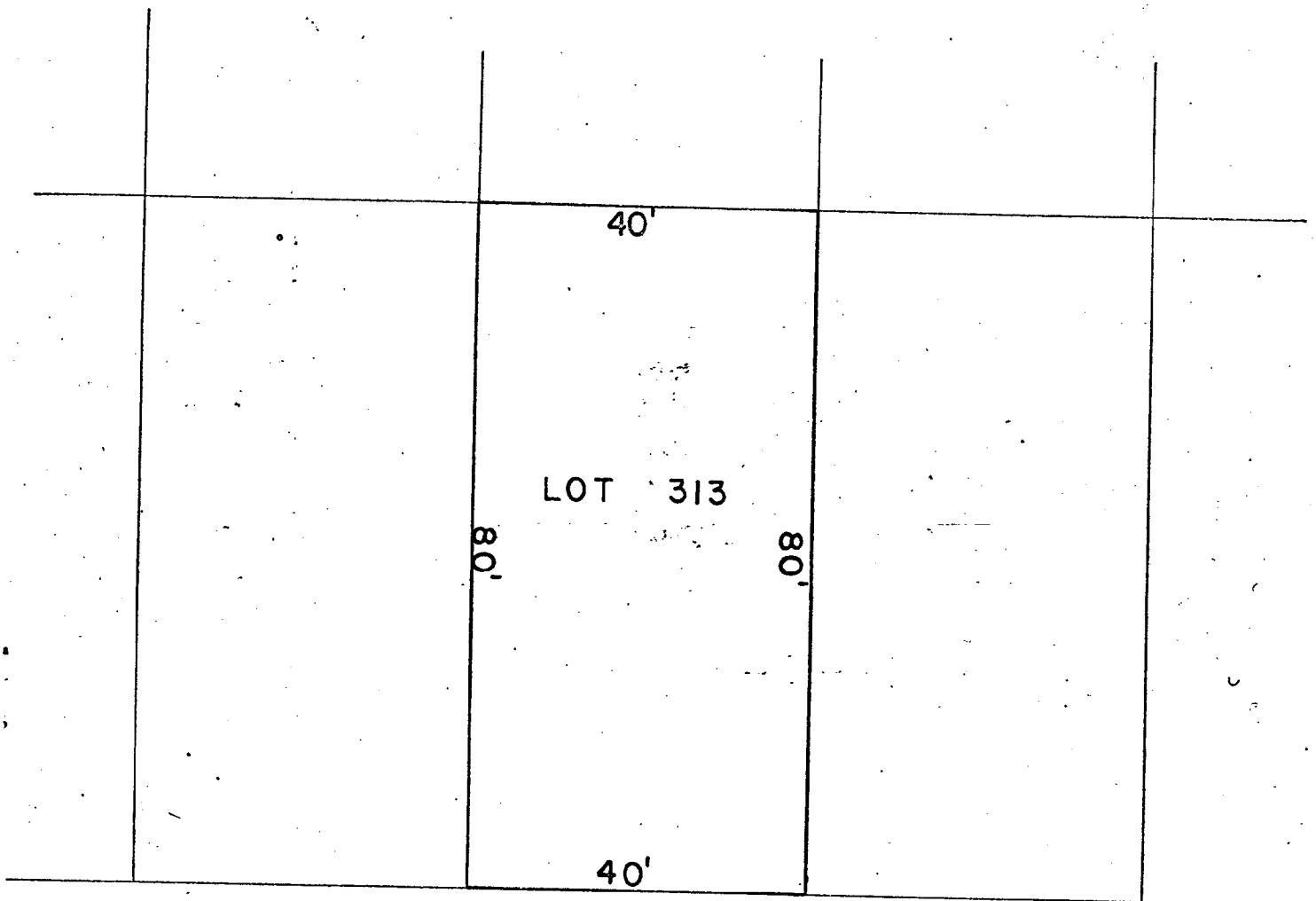



Rules of Procedure approved by the Committee on Licenses

All applications for additional storage facilities shall be accompanied by a list in duplicate of owners of property and their addresses within 150-foot radius of the boundaries of the lot or lots upon which the proposed facility is to be located.

All other applications for storage and sale of petroleum products shall be filed in the Office of the Director of Building Inspection and shall include:

1. Duplicate copies of location plat which shall be a clear and legible drawing or blue print of that portion of the City Assessor's Plat upon which the proposed facility is to be located. The size of the location plat shall be either $8\frac{1}{2}$ x 14 or 14 x 17 and shall be drawn on the same scale as the City Assessor's Plat. The plat shall indicate thereon street and lot lines within a 150-foot radius of the lot or lots upon which the proposed facility is to be located. The area of the proposed facility, as indicated on the location plat, shall be defined by a distinct line.
2. A plot plan in triplicate of the lot or lots upon which the facility is to be located, scaled 1/4 inch for every foot, showing the location of pumps, driveways, buildings, ramps, and any other structures affected by the proposed change in curb openings.
3. A list in duplicate on separate sheets of the names and addresses of owners of all lots within a 150-foot radius of the boundaries of the lot or lots upon which the facility is to be located.

4. Applications shall be signed by the owner or his agent and shall include his address.

All applications must be approved in writing by the Commissioner of Public Safety, The Director of Public Works, The Traffic Engineer, and The Director of the Department of Building Inspection before said applications may be filed with the Committee on Licenses of the City Council. No application will be considered by the Committee on Licenses unless approved by all Department Heads concerned and unless filed with the Committee at least ten days prior to the date of the next scheduled Committee Hearing.

Whenever a Department Head fails to approve an application or must delay his consideration of such application, he shall so inform, in writing, the Committee on Licenses of such action and the reason therefore.

All proposed sites shall be inspected by the Committee on Licenses and such other Department Heads as it may deem necessary.
