CHAPTER 1582

No. 1 AN ORDINANCE IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 1577
APPROVED NOVEMBER 8, 1963 PERMITTING BURNING OF COMBUSTIBLE
RUBBLE MATERIAL AT FIELDS POINT.

Approved January 3, 1964

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 1577 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved November 8, 1963 being "An Ordinance Declaring that an Emergency Exists and Amending Section 1159.7 of Chapter 1079 of the 1956 Ordinance Relative to Open Fires, and Permitting Burning of Combustible Rubble Material at Fields Point" is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The Director of Public Works shall collect for each load of combustible rubble material delivered to said Fields Point the sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars".

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

No. 2 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE,
CHAPTER 1565 BY APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF THIRTY
FIVE THOUSAND (\$35,000) DOLLARS TO SCHOOL DEPARTMENT.

Approved January 3, 1964

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1565 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 24, 1963, entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$44,468,244.36 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1964", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Thirty-Five Thousand (\$35,000) Dollars to SCHOOL DEPARTMENT.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Thirty-Five Thousand (\$35,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account are hereby increased by Thirty Five Thousand (\$35,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 6

Approved January 3, 1964

RESOLVED,

THAT all Department Heads shall grant leaves of absence, without loss of compensation, to employees, in their respective Departments, who have served in the Armed Forces of the United States of America; have been honorably discharged, following such service; are members in good standing of such veterans' organizations as have been Chartered by the Congress of the United States, and who desire and apply to attend National Conventions of their respective Veterans Organizations, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

THAT for the purpose of verifying such war service records and membership in such Veterans Organizations of said employees who apply for such leaves of absence, the City Council shall create a Special Committee of five of its members who shall be appointed by the President of the City Council, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,

THAT Department Heads, whose employees indicate such desire for such leaves of absence, shall transmit forthwith to this Special Committee, such requests, in writing and present such evidence of membership by such employee, as set forth in this Resolution.
