RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE NEWLY CONSTRUCTED CITY SWIMMING POOL AT NEUTACONKANUT PARK AS STEPHEN ALMAGNO MEMORIAL SWIMMING POOL.

WHEREAS, the City of Providence has recently constructed a swimming pool at Neutaconkanut Park to serve the youth of our community and to contribute to their recreational and athletic development; and

WHEREAS, there lived in this same community a fine, revered, human being of good will named Stephen Almagno who himself well and nobly served the youth of our neighborhoods and contributed greatly to their recreational and athletic development, and who had the following background:

Born on October 24, 1912 in Providence, Rhode Island;  
Attended Providence Public Schools including Technical High School;  
Married November 14, 1936 to Theresa LaFazia of Providence;  
Father of two sons - Father Romano Stephen Almagno O.F.M.  
and Joseph Almagno, presently a teacher in Providence;  
By early training a carpenter until he became a member of Providence Fire Department on January 11, 1942, in which he served honorably and competently for sixteen years until his death on November 18, 1957;

WHEREAS, throughout his short life he worked tirelessly for and gave generously of himself to the betterment of the youth of our City, and had himself tried to have the City construct a swimming pool at Neutaconkanut Park; and

WHEREAS, he is generally credited with being the founder of Little League Baseball in the Silver Lake - Olneyville and Federal Hill areas, and having received a franchise from National Little League headquarters, he proceeded to organize Little League in that area, later being elected its President; Stephen Almagno also organized the St. Bartholomew's Cadet League baseball team and served as its manager; and

WHEREAS, Stephen Almagno served actively in other service, community, and religious organizations including St. Bartholomew's Holy Name Society, Third Order of St. Francis, Apostleship of Prayer, the National Police and Fire Association, Stripers Club, New England Fire Photo-
