

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 214

Approved April 15, 1977

WHEREAS, it has been reported that the salaries of certain employees in the Board of Canvassers and Registration have been certified by the said Board and transmitted to the City Controller to be honored, were being intercepted by the Personnel Director and altered inconsistent with the approval of the said Board, and

WHEREAS, it has been further reported that certain salary checks are not delivered, in the usual manner, to the Board of Canvassers and Registration, but were in fact, given to certain employees after having been altered, and

WHEREAS, it appears that this practice is in violation of the City's standard procedure in its payments of salaries to its employees and possibly in conflict with the agreement between the City of Providence, and the Public Service Employees Local Union 1033, effective July 1, 1976 to June 30, 1979.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Committee on Employee Relations of the City Council is hereby authorized to investigate this reported illegal procedure and to request the appearance before it of the Personnel Director and the Members of the Board of Canvassers and Registration.
