

This letter is to confirm our conversation today and to ask that you place the following road closure request on the City Council agenda, to be considered at the next meeting of the Council.

We respectfully request that the City permit the closure of Gaspee and Francis Streets, as well as the north end of the new access bridge which intersects those streets, in order to conduct our bicycle race, the first stage of the MAZDA Ocean State Race Weekend, on Saturday July 27, 1991, from 7 AM until 6 PM.


The race course runs around the State House, including Gaspee, Francis and Smith Streets. The State DOT has been asked for permission to close that section of Smith Street.


