No. 216

Approved April 22, 1982

RESOLVED, That the Traffic Engineer is hereby requested to prohibit Motor Vehicle Traffic along Sheldon Street, between Benefit and Traverse Streets from 6:30 o'clock P.M. to 10:30 o'clock P.M. on Friday, May 7, 1982; along Cooke Street, between Angell Street and Young Orchard Avenue, as well as the perpendicular streets: Manning, George and Benevolent Streets, from 9:30 o'clock A.M. to 4:15 o'clock P.M. on Saturday, May 8, 1982; and along Power Street, between Brook and Cooke Streets, from 6:30 o'clock P.M. to 10:30 o'clock P.M., to accommodate the Providence Preservation Society in sponsoring the Festival of Historic Houses.

Dear Mrs. Brassil:

Thank you for your cooperation in helping to make the 1982 Festival of Historic Houses run smoothly. We appreciate your willingness to sponsor a resolution in the City Council providing for the temporary closing of the streets in the Festival area. I have enclosed a map showing the locations where we hope barriers can be placed.

Essentially, this is what is required. The Festival is May 7 & 8, with an evening Candlelight Tour on Friday, May 7th from 7:00 to 10:00 p.m., another Candlelight Tour on Saturday evening, 7:00 to 10:00 p.m., and a House & Garden Tour on Saturday from 10:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.


On Friday evening, we would like Sheldon Street between Benefit and Traverse closed to traffic between 6:30 and 10:30 p.m.

On Saturday, May 8th from 9:30 a.m. to 4:15 p.m. we will need Cooke Street between Angell and Young Orchard closed, as well as the perpendicular streets: Manning, George, and Benevolent, as indicated on the map.

Saturday evening, from 6:30 to 10:30 p.m. Power Street between Brook and Cooke, and Cooke Street between Young Orchard Avenue and Power Street should be closed.

I have talked with Sgt. Gerald Aubin in the Police Department about this, so that he is aware of the request for assistance. We are so appreciative of your help with this matter.

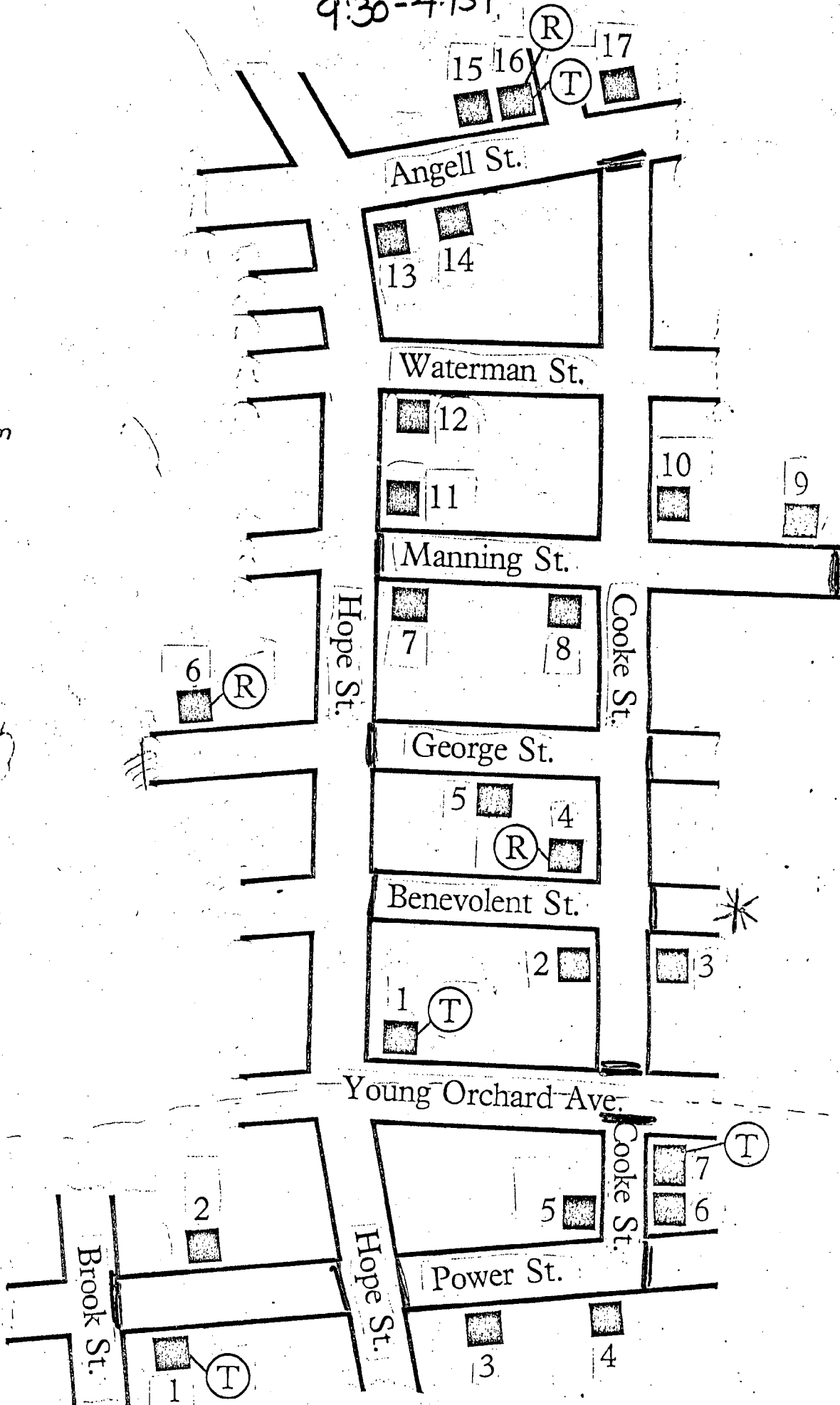
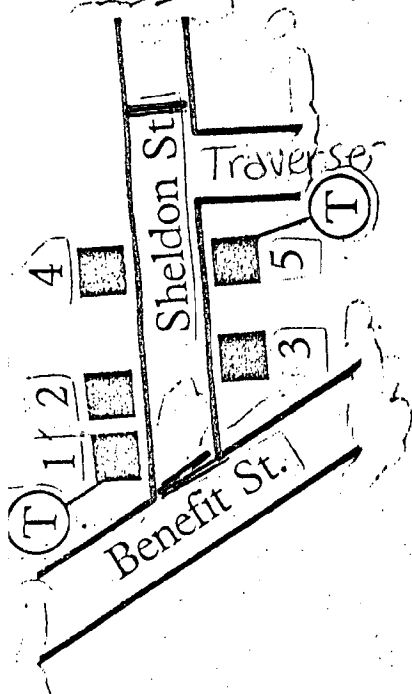

Dear Councilman Xavier:

The Providence Preservation Society is again sponsoring the Festival of Historic Houses, May 7-8, this year. This is a special weekend when we offer tours of historic houses in Providence and invite not only Providence residents but also people from across the nation to take part in the Festival. The occasion draws several hundred people to our city from neighboring states.

For the Festival we are offering two evening Candlelight Tours and a daytime House & Garden Tour. This year most of the Festival area lies within the First Ward. Consequently, we are requesting assistance from you and Councilwoman Brassil in introducing a resolution in the City Council to have the streets closed during the tour. I have enclosed a map showing the locations of the tours and spots where a barrier is needed. I have talked with Sgt. Gerald Aubin of the Police Department, and he is prepared to assist us.

Essentially, this is what is required. On Friday evening, May 7th between 6:30 and 10:30 p.m. we would need to have Sheldon Street between Benefit and Traverse closed to traffic. On Saturday evening from 6:30 to 10:30 p.m. Power Street between Brook and Cooke, and Cooke Street between Young Orchard Avenue and Power Street should be blocked to traffic. On Saturday from 9:30 a.m. until 4:15 Cooke Street between Angell and Young Orchard Avenue and the perpendicular streets, Manning, George and Benevolent should be closed. While we have several homes open on Angell and Waterman Streets, we recognize that it would be impossible to close them.

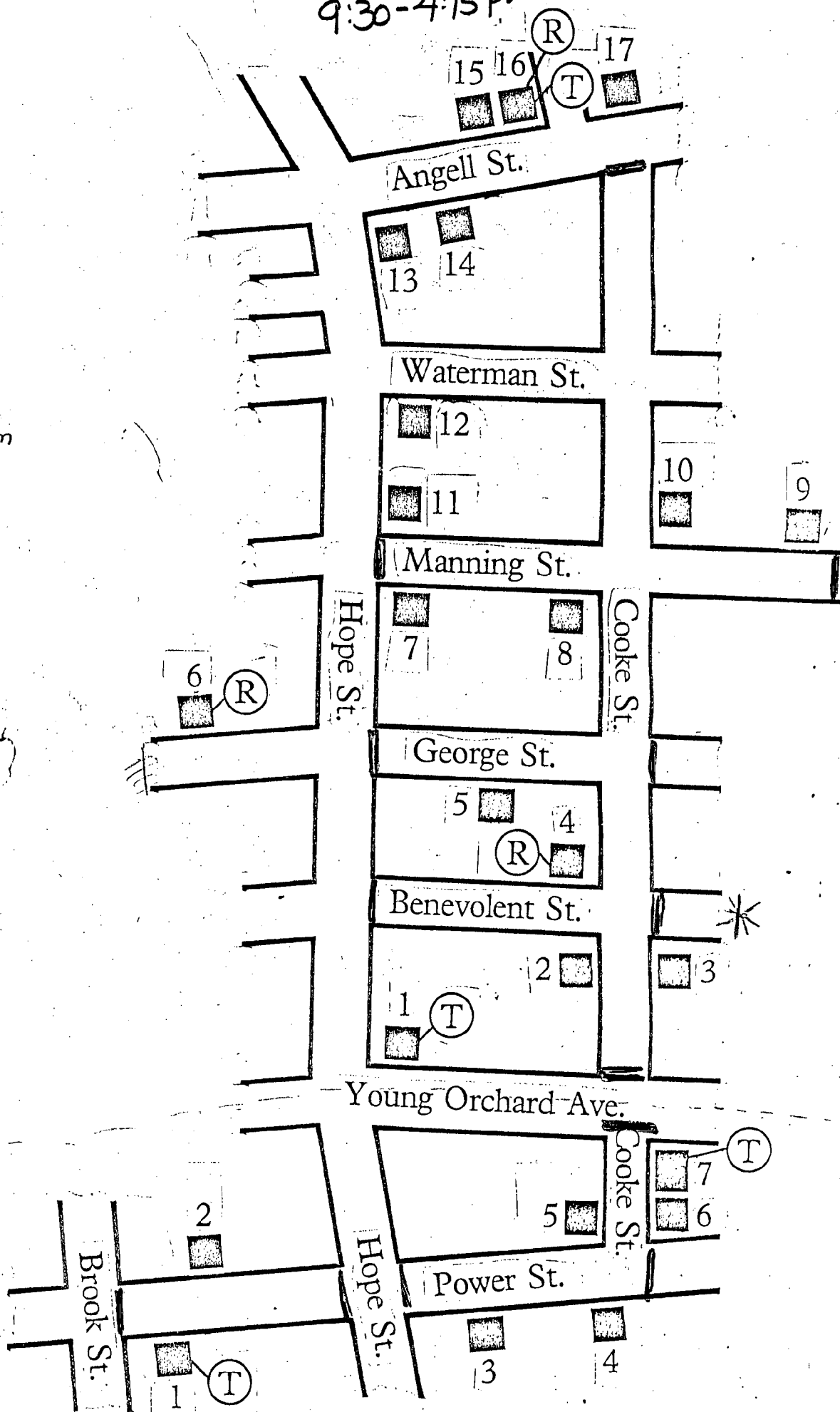
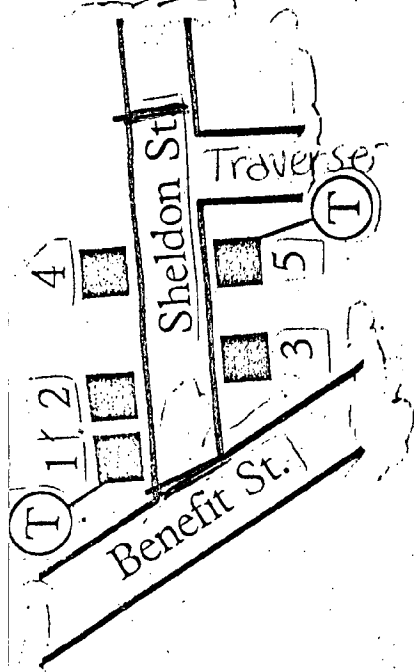
