

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 120

Approved February 26, 1974

WHEREAS, Edmund M. Mauro, Sr., late former Chairman of the Providence Redevelopment Agency from May 8, 1962 to May 9, 1972, having served as one of the original members of that agency since its inception, has been called by Almighty God to his Eternal Reward, and

WHEREAS, ever giving of himself to this unsalaried chairmanship post, with his personal interest in the City's Urban Redevelopment Program, which was reflected in his personal efforts to negotiate agreements with potential developers, he made this post an almost full-time job, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Mauro was Founder, Past President, and Board Chairman of the International Supply Company, and

WHEREAS, ever active in organizations and giving of his time, he served as a member of the State Parole Board, was a former director of the Oyster Harbor Club in Osterville, Massachusetts, and a former director of IMPACT,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that His Honor, Mayor Joseph A. Doorley, Jr., and the Members of the City Council of the City of Providence, Rhode Island, in noting the passing of Edmund M.
