RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 24

Approved January 13, 1984

WHEREAS, Stephen D. Bradley was born in Providence on August 10, 1955, the son of Edward Bradley, Jr. and Evelyn Bradley, and

WHEREAS, He was educated in Providence Public Schools, a graduate of the Reservoir Avenue School, Gilbert Stuart Junior High and Central High School, and

WHEREAS, He worked at Reservoir Avenue Auto Parts and United Auto Body, and

WHEREAS, He enlisted in August 1975 in the United States Army and rose to the rank of Sergeant, and

WHEREAS, He died while on active duty in Germany on August 12, 1979, and

WHEREAS, This City of Providence has a long tradition of honoring its native sons who, through the years, have forfeited their lives in the protection of those rights and principles on which our great nation was founded,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the intersection of Reservoir Avenue and Downing Street is dedicated to the memory of the late Stephen D. Bradley and is to be hereafter known as the "Sergeant Stephen D. Bradley Memorial Square," and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That as an expression of sympathy on behalf of the Members of the City Council and the entire citizenry of Providence, the City Clerk is directed to cause a duly engrossed copy of this Resolution to be transmitted to the Bradley Family, and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works is to cause a suitable plaque to be erected at the intersection of Reservoir Avenue and Downing Street, that the public be aware of the action here taken.
