**ELECTION OF PRESIDENT OF CITY COUNCIL:**


PRESIDING OFFICER IGLIOZZI calls for Nominations for the Office of the President of the City Council for the remainder of the Term 1995-1999.


The Clerk casts one ballot as directed.
