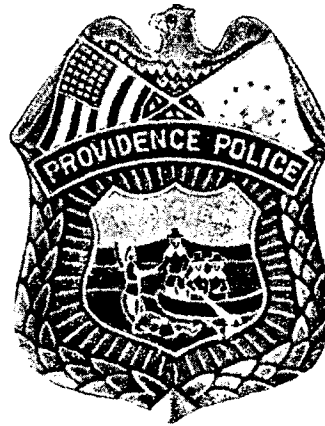

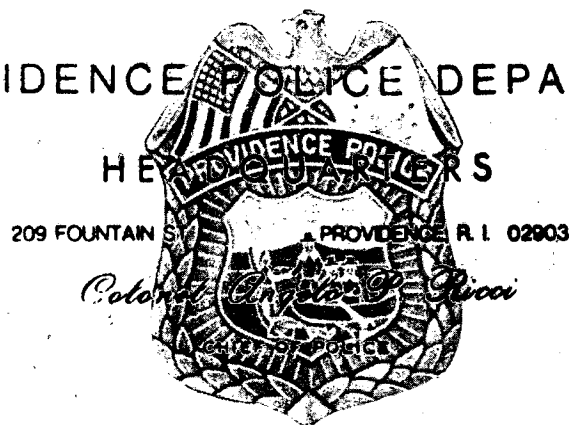

The following pages represent the formal presentation of the one hundred and sixteenth annual report of the Providence Police Department, covering the calendar year 1980.

While statistical analysis is somewhat constrained in its ability to depict the nuances of social and economic problems, and their relationship with the frequency of reported crime, only a cursory examination of this report will indicate the magnitude of our determination in repressing and preventing criminal activity throughout our jurisdiction.

Although Providence, like most other Northeastern cities, experienced an increase in the frequency of reported Part I Offenses, it is felt that a continuation of our formal policy of stern enforcement coupled with effective police-community relations will continue to limit the impact of crime upon our citizenry.

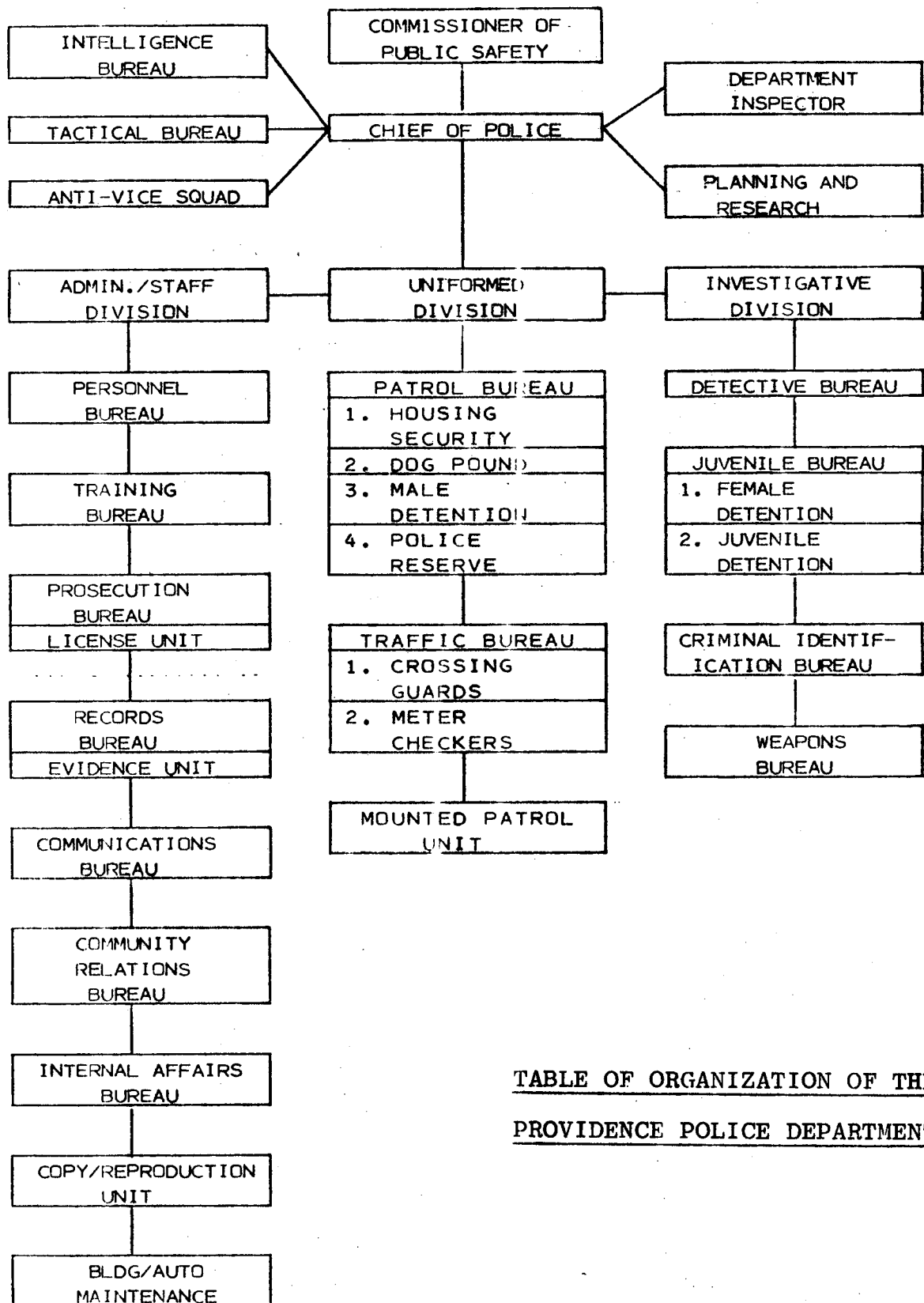
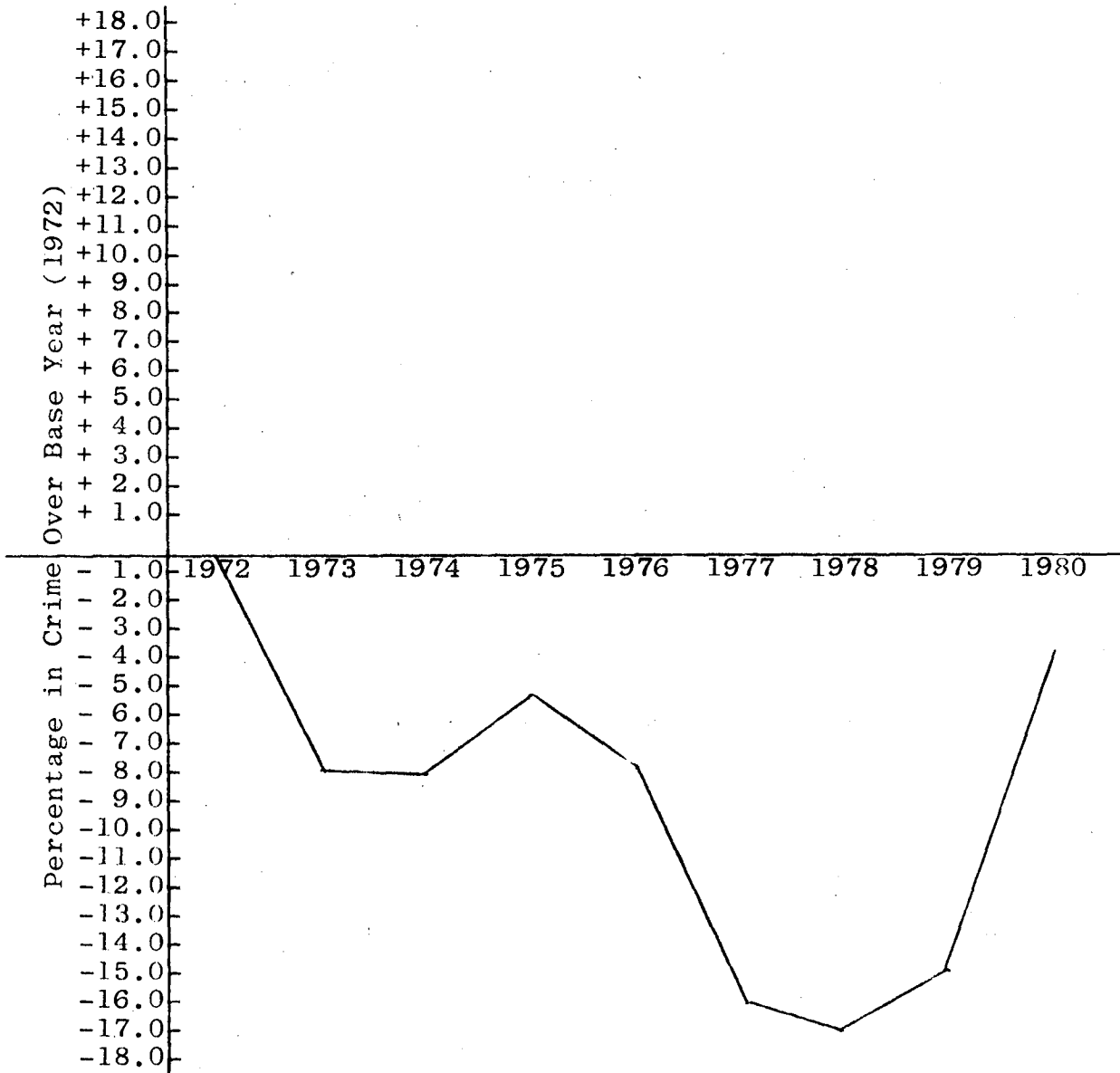

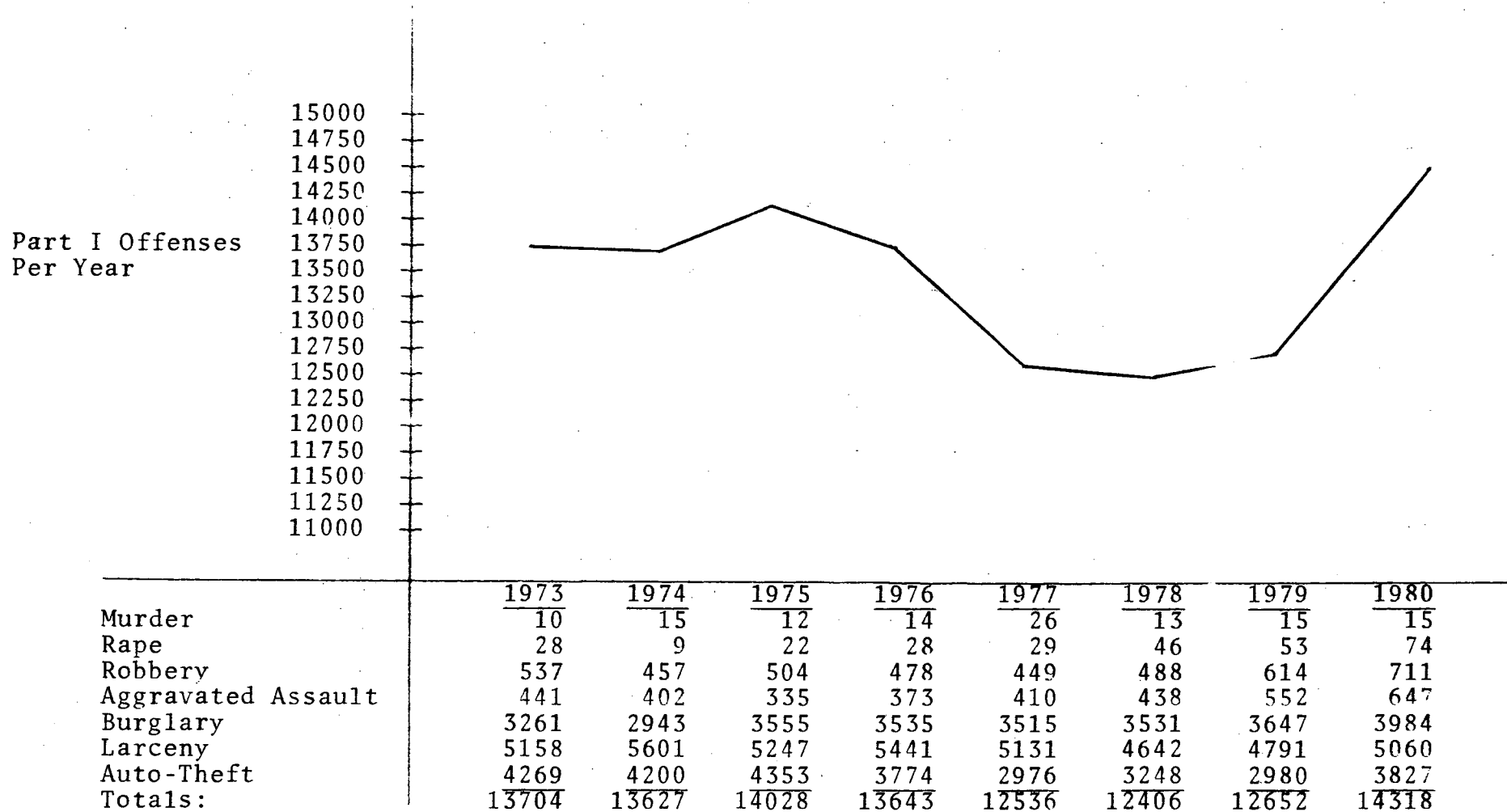

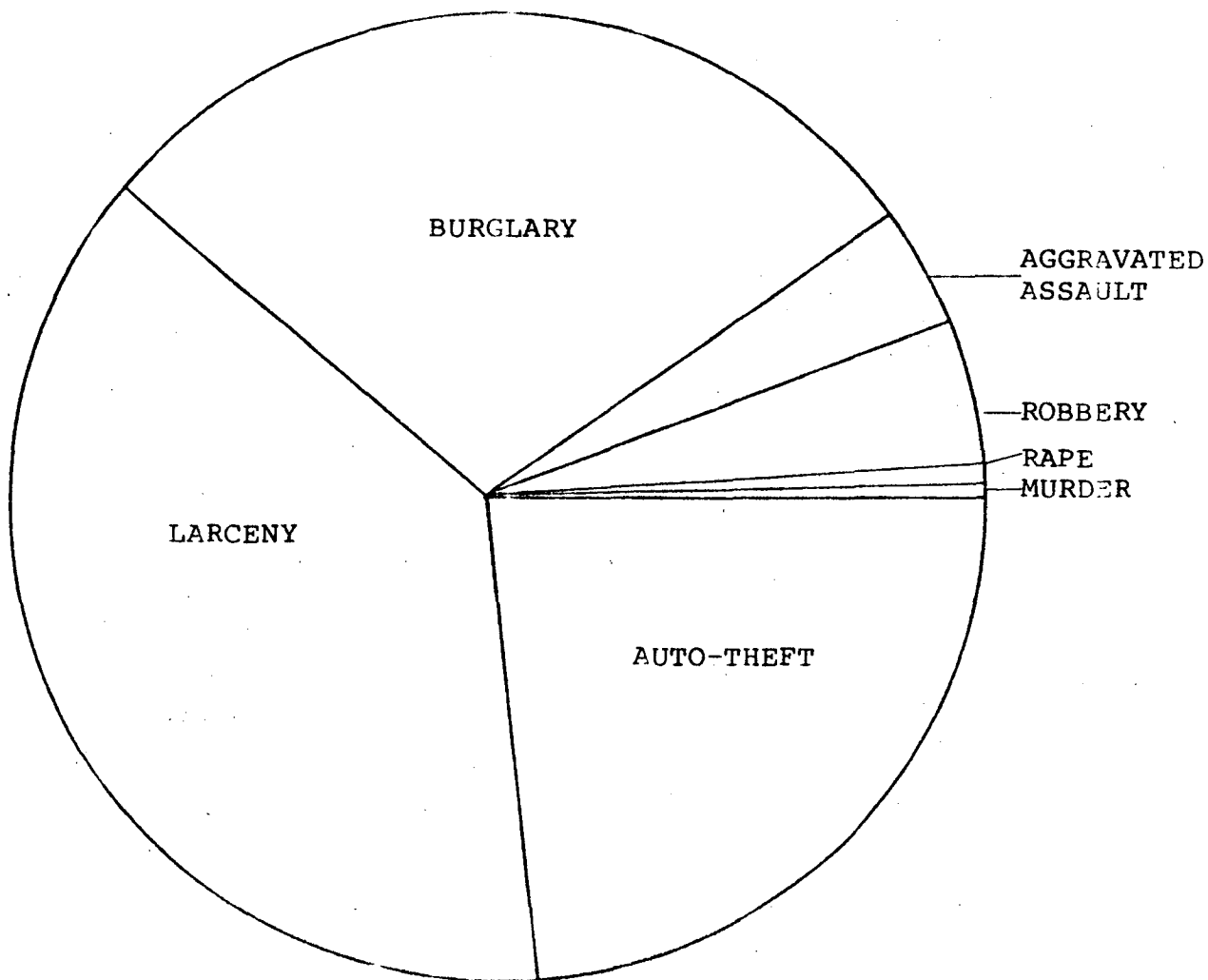

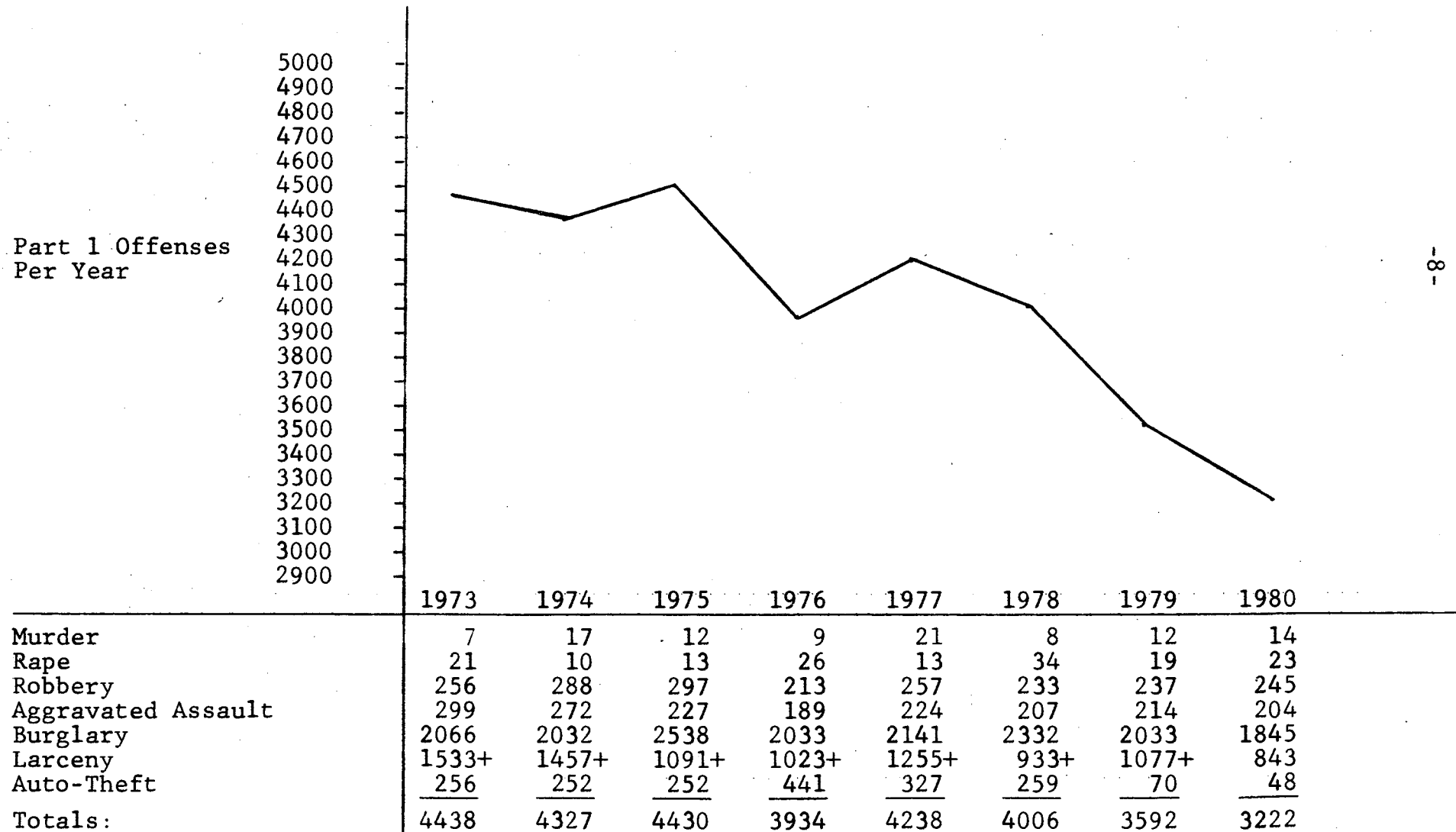
Percent Decomposition of Part I Offenses

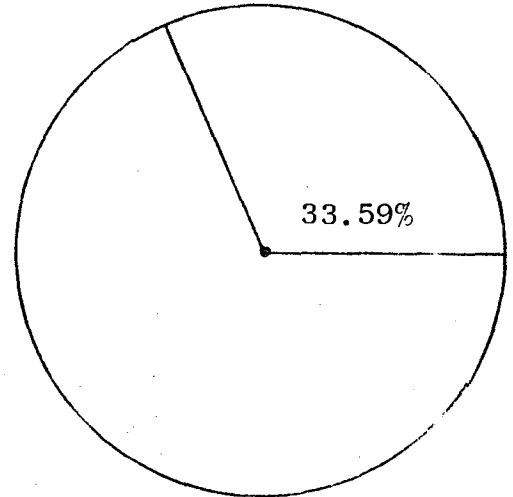

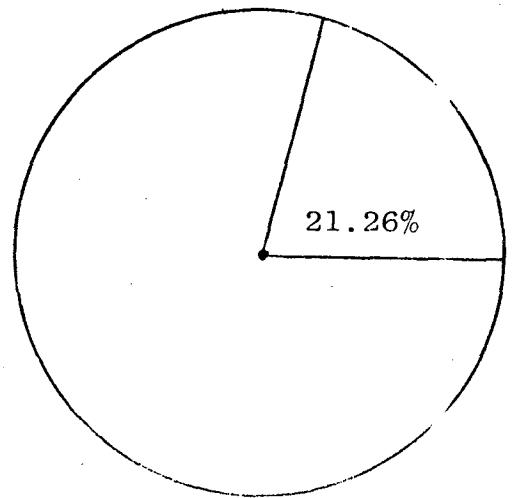

CLEARANCES OF PART I OFFENSES REPORTED TO THE POLICE

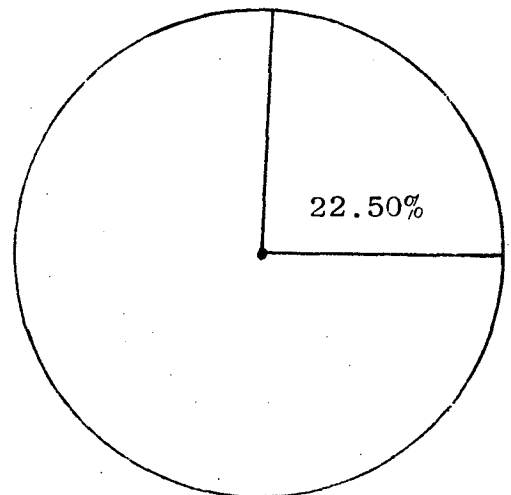

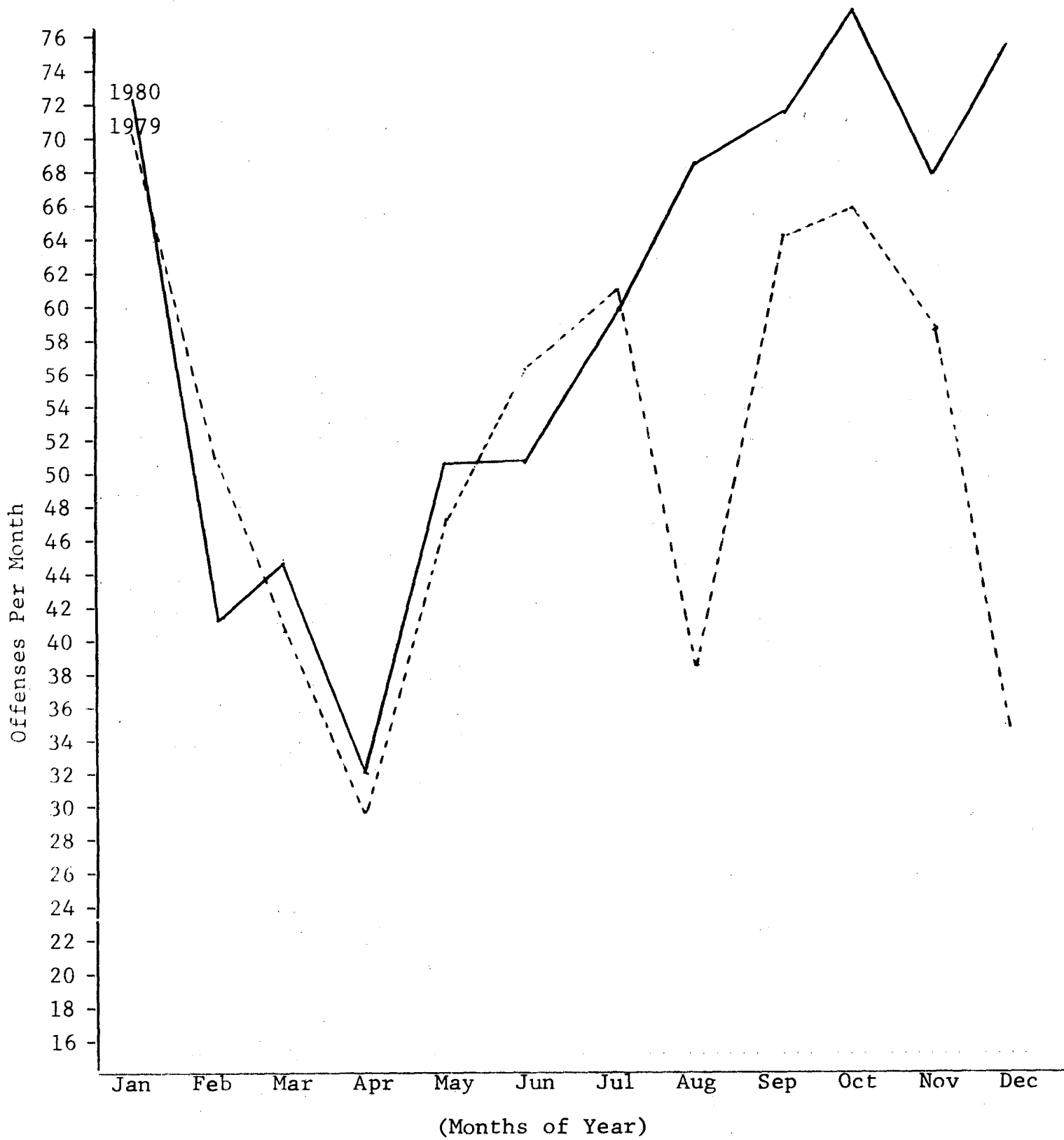

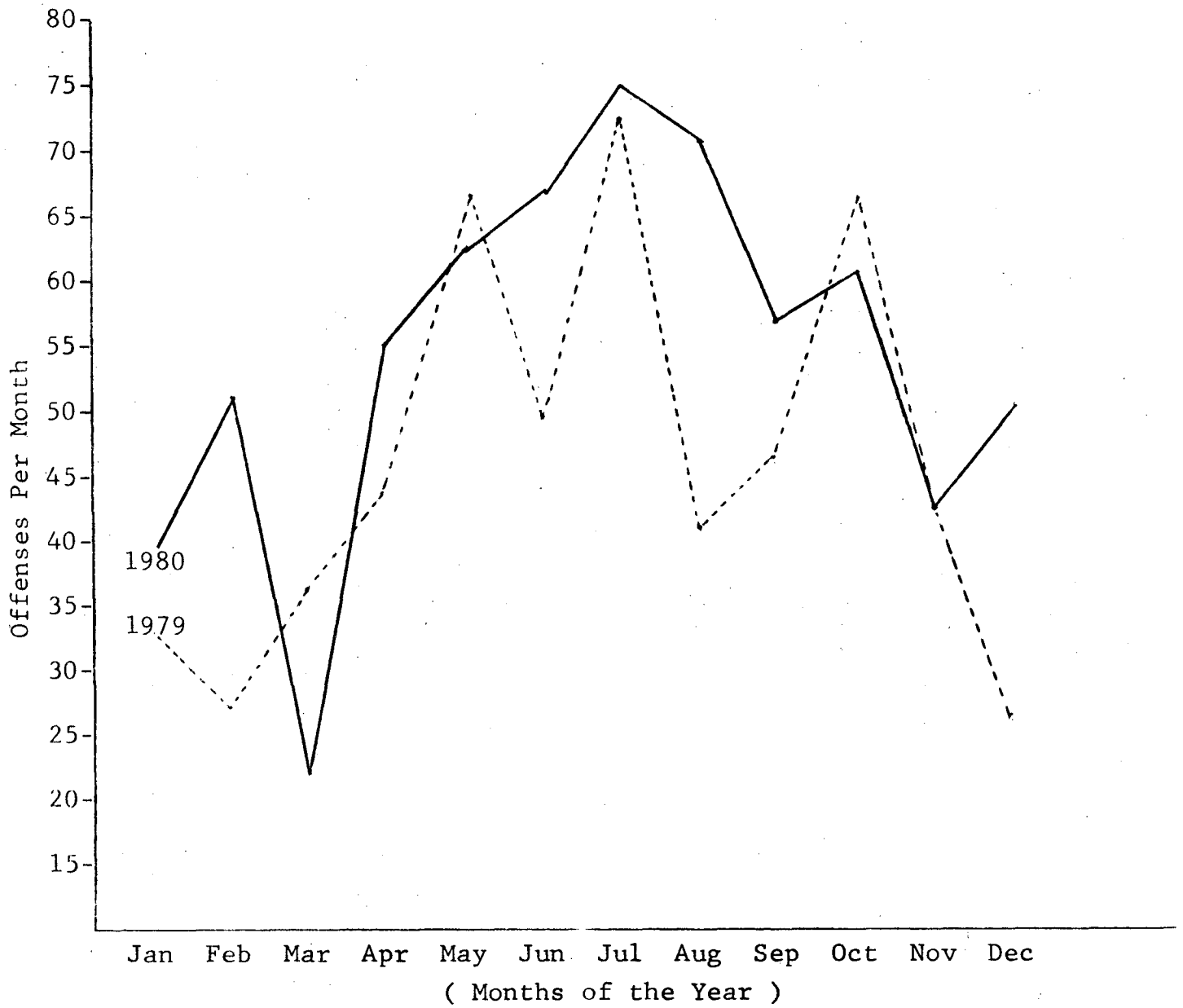


Graphical History of the  
Various Part I Offenses

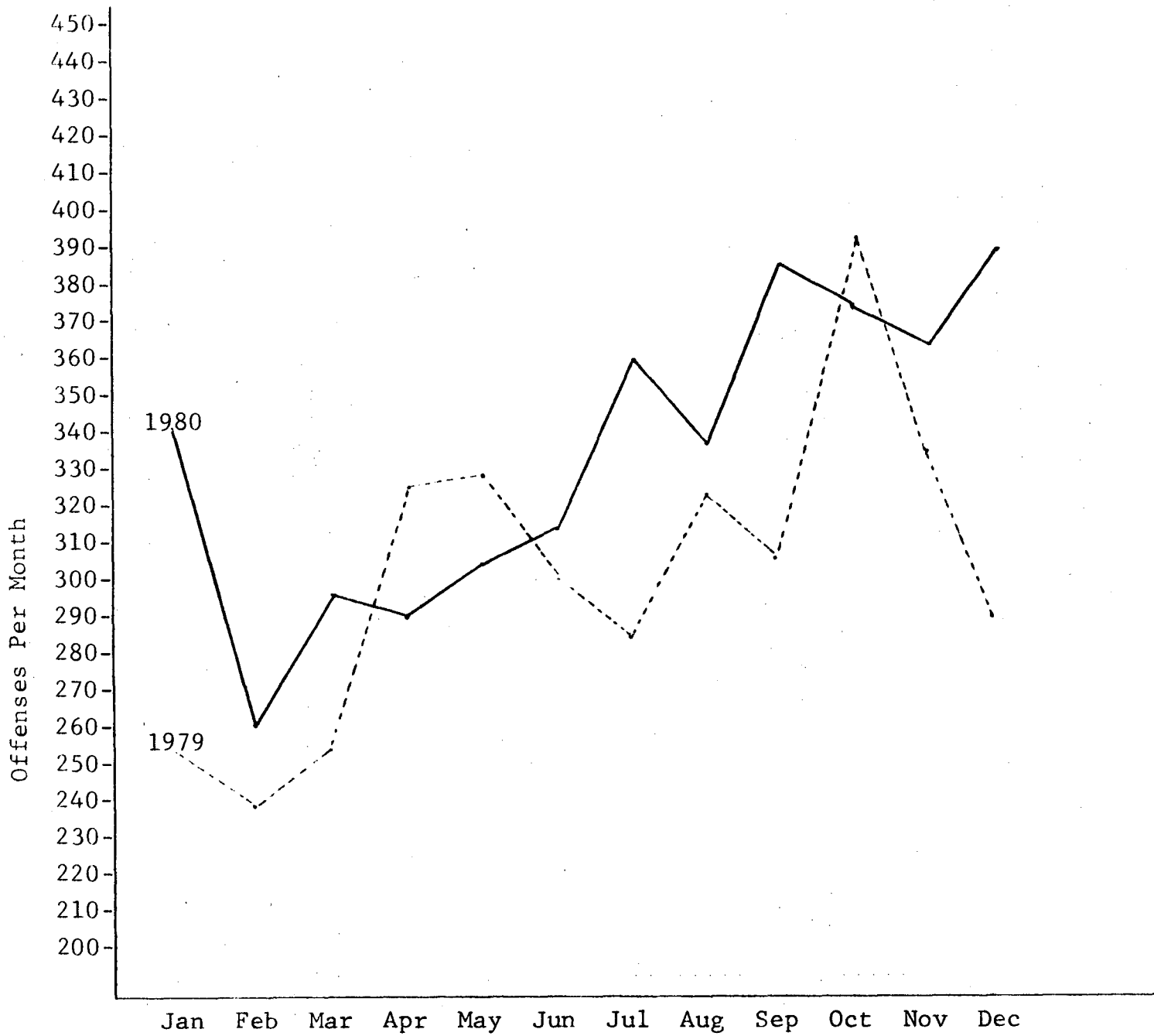

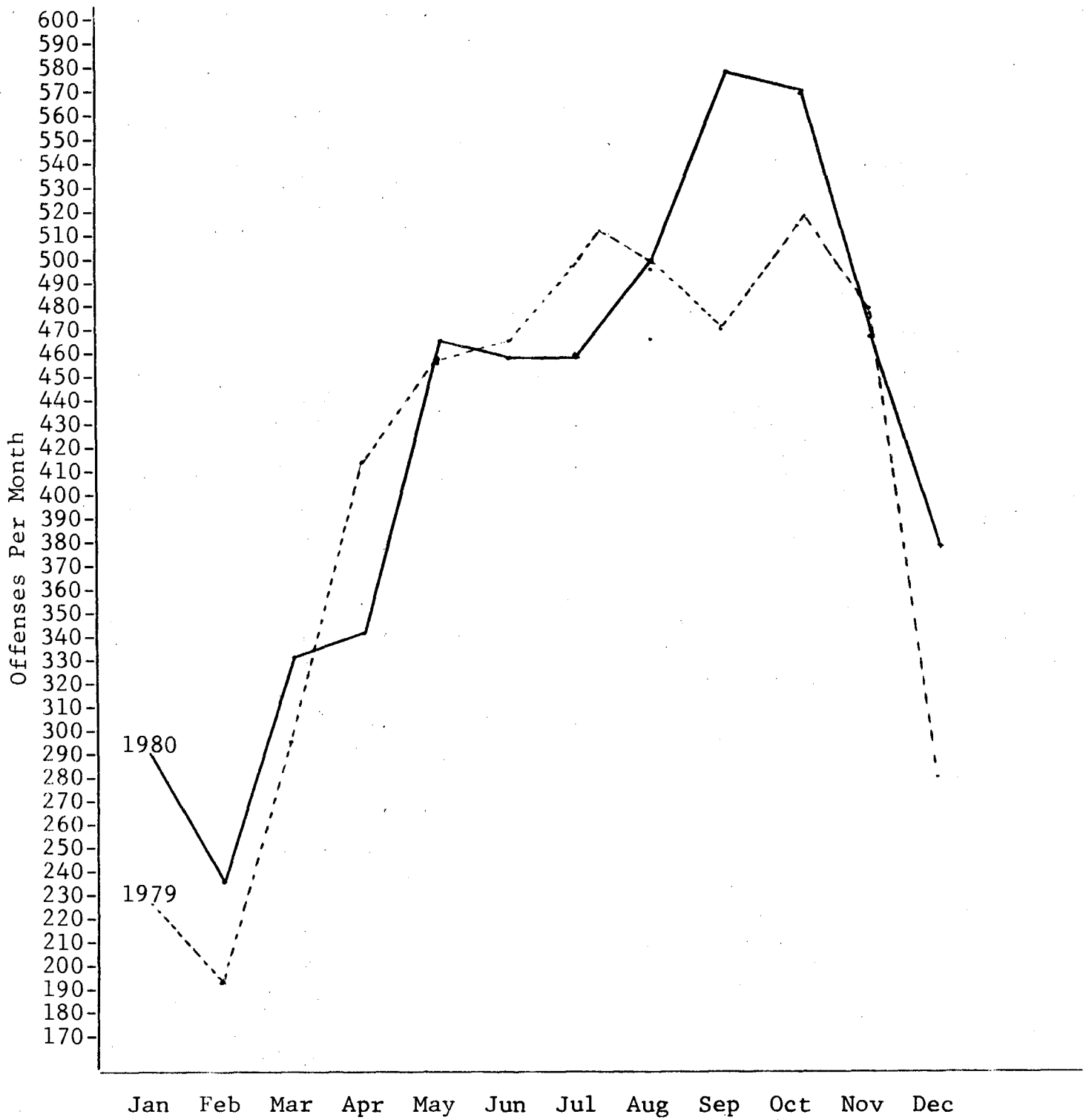
COMPARATIVE HISTORY OF ROBBERY  
(1980 vs. 1979)



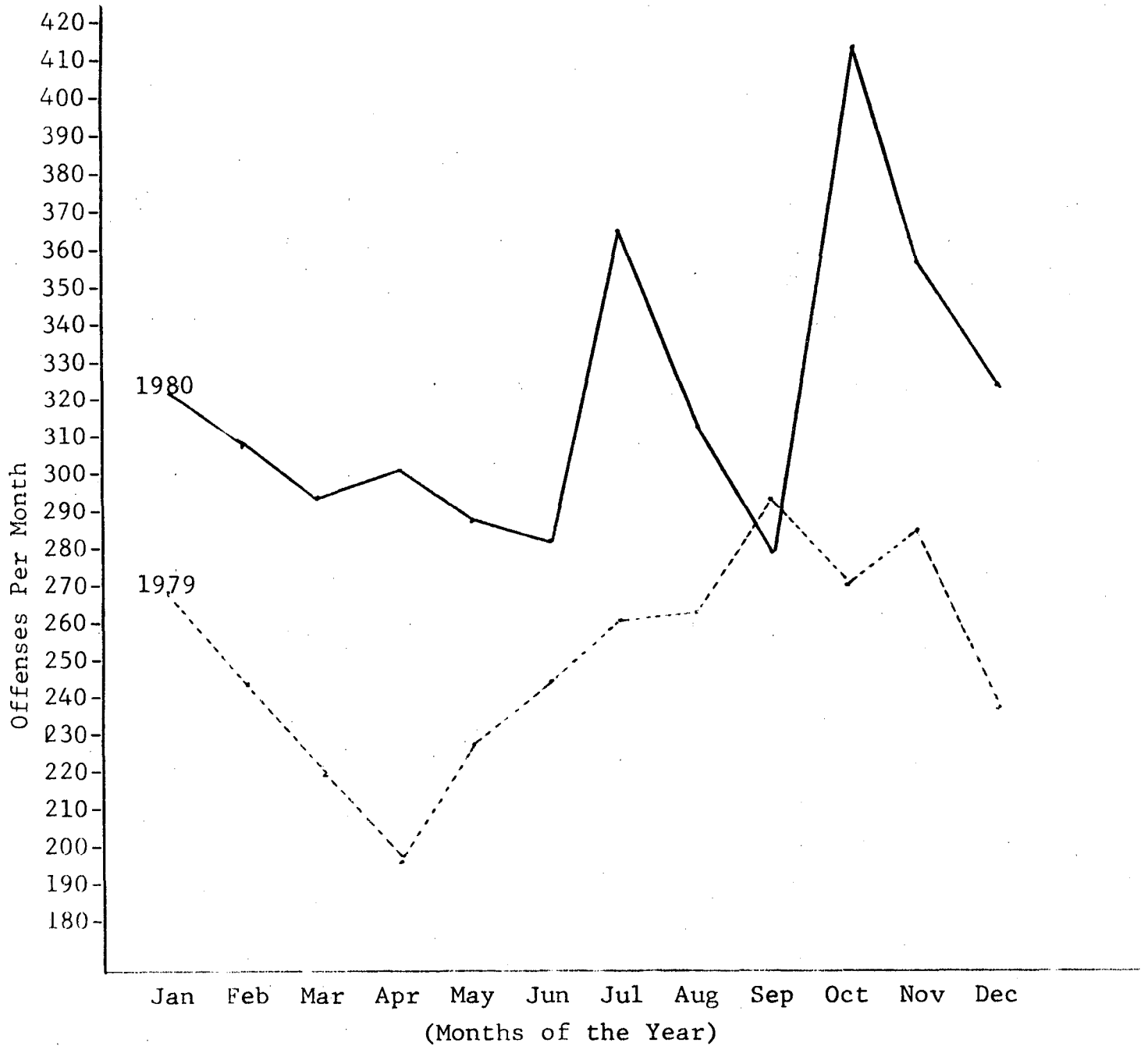
COMPARATIVE HISTORY OF ASSAULT

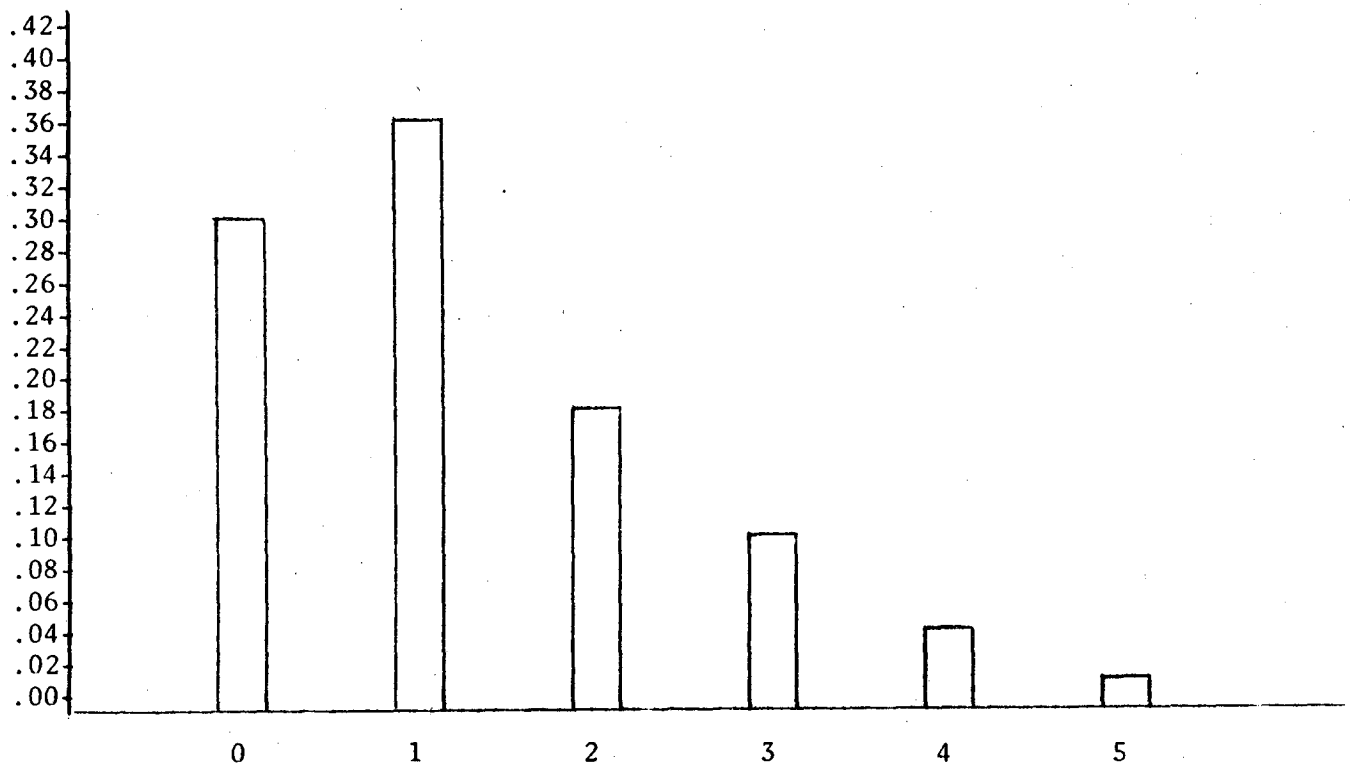
