RESOLUTION OF THE PROVIDENCE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE FILING BY THE CITY OF AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING UNDER THE HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 1974.

WHEREAS, the City of Providence is eligible to receive Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Funds for fiscal year 1975 under Section 106 (a) or (h) of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-383).

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Providence City Council that:

1. The City Council of the City of Providence, County of Providence, State of Rhode Island, hereby authorizes the City of Providence, through its official representative, the Mayor, to file an application for Community Development Block Grant Entitlement Funds for fiscal year 1975 under Section 106 (a) or (h) of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-383) to do all acts necessary to successfully acquire said funds.
2. The expenditure of all funds for specific activities and programs under this application shall be by resolution of the City Council.
3. The Mayor and City Council may require any and all information relative to the expenditure of Community Development Act funds and at any time conduct investigations pursuant to the existing provisions of the City Charter.

4. There shall be submitted to the City Council and the Citizens Advisory Committee by the City Treasurer on a monthly basis a line item budget showing (a) Project Account (b) Amount budgeted (c) Amount expended (d) balance

5. The Mayor shall submit to the City Council and the Citizens Advisory Committee on a Quarterly basis a narrative progress report on each program including supporting data.

6. The Mayor shall be responsible for negotiating all contracts with outside agencies subject to approval by resolution of the City Council.

7. Amendments to the Community Development Program during the program year necessitating the reallocation of funds or the designation of new activities shall be subject to at least one Public Hearing, review by the Citizens Advisory Committee and final approval by resolution of the City Council.
