RESOLVED,

THAT, the sum of FIFTEEN THOUSAND (\$15,000) Dollars is hereby ordered transferred by the Board of Commissioners of Sinking Funds from the "FIRE INSURANCE FUND" established by Section 38 of Chapter 2 of the Revised Ordinances of 1946, entitled, "FIRE INSURANCE FUND" to a separate account in the Capital Fund to be known as, "NATHAN BISHOP JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL FIRE DAMAGE FUND".
