questions were approved by the voters of the City of Providence on the dates
and by the votes indicated below:

1. BRIDGES AND VIADUCTS--BONDS NOT MORE THAN \$1,500,000
(Chapter 67--Public Laws of 1971)

"Shall an act, passed at the 1971 session of the general assembly, entitled
'An act providing for inspecting, reconstructing, rehabilitating, repairing
and maintaining bridges and viaducts by the city of Providence and authorizing
the financing thereof, including the issue of not more than \$1,500,000 bonds
therefor' be approved?"

Approved General Election November 7, 1972 by the following vote:

Approve: 26,898
Reject: 23,076

2. SEAWALL AT FIELDS POINT AND ADDITIONAL DOCKING AND SUPPORT
FACILITIES--NOT MORE THAN \$6,500,000
(Chapter 79--Public Laws of 1971)

"Shall an act, passed at the 1971 session of the general assembly, entitled
'An act providing for repairing the existing seawall at Fields Point and
constructing and extension thereof and for constructing additional docking
and support facilities by the city of Providence and authorizing the financ-
ing thereof, including the issue of not more than \$6,500,000 bonds therefor'
be approved?"

Approved General Election November 7, 1972 by the following vote:

Approve: 28,873
Reject: 21,251

3. SCHOOLS--ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION, RECONSTRUCTION AND
EQUIPMENT (\$7,000,000)
(Chapter 142--Public Laws of 1971)

"Shall an act, passed at the 1971 session of the general assembly, entitled
'An act providing for acquiring land for and constructing, equipping and
furnishing new schools and additions to existing schools and for acquiring
land and buildings to be used for school purposes, for reconstructing, re-
habilitating and modernizing such buildings and for providing equipment and
furnishings in connection therewith' be approved?"

Approved General Election November 7, 1972 by the following vote:

Approve: 32,070
Reject: 18,496

4. MUNICIPAL DOCK BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES--BONDS NOT MORE THAN
\$1,500,000
(Chapter 251--Public Laws of 1971)

"Shall an act, passed at the 1971 session of the general assembly, entitled
'An act providing for remodeling, reconstructing, rehabilitating, modern-
izing and improving municipal dock buildings and facilities by the city of
Providence and authorizing the financing thereof, including the issue of not
more than \$1,500,000 bonds therefor' be approved?"

Approved General Election November 7, 1972 by the following vote:

Approve: 26,241
Reject: 22,166
