
On the field trip it was found that the area in question is at present occupied by a one-family dwelling, the surrounding area is predominantly in one-family use.



SUBJECT: REFERRAL NO. 585 - ZONING CHANGE AT THE CORNER OF HUMBOLDT AVENUE
AND ELTON STREET

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, February 23, 1954.

This referral is a request for a change in zoning from an R-1 Zone to an R-4 Zone of Lot 247 on Assessor's Plat 39 located on the southwesterly corner of Humboldt Avenue and Elton Street, and containing 9,701 square feet of land area.

Reference is made to Referral No. 375, dated November 14, 1951, in which Lot 247 on Assessor's Plat 39 was petitioned for rezoning from an R-1 Zone to an R-4 Zone. The Commission's recommendation for denial was upheld by the City Council.

On the field trip it was found that the area in question is at present occupied by a four-car garage. A portion of the lot has been excavated, possibly for cellar purposes. The surrounding area is predominantly one and two-family dwellings. To the east and directly across the street lies the Gladys Potter Garden Park.

Considering the arrangement and general characteristics of the surrounding neighborhood this change in zoning would not be appropriate to the use of neighboring properties, and in order to avoid a case of spot zoning
