No. 356 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 886 BY ADDING THE SUM OF FORTY FIVE HUNDRED (\$4,500.00) DOLLARS TO THE APPROPRIATIONS CONTAINED THEREIN FOR GRANTS TO OUTSIDE AGENCIES.

Approved May 23, 1955

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

Section 1. Chapter 886 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence as approved September 17, 1954, entitled "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$30,448,534.47 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1955", as amended, is hereby further amended by adding the sum of FORTY FIVE HUNDRED (\$4,500.00) DOLLARS as an appropriation for McKenna-McAllister Post No. 592, Veterans of Foreign Wars, under the item Grants to Outside Agencies and Institutions.

Sec. 2. The said sum shall be paid to said Post as a contribution to meet part of the cost of acquiring new building facilities for the use of said Post and such contribution shall be upon such terms and conditions as His Honor the Mayor may see fit to impose.

Sec. 3. The said sum of FORTY FIVE HUNDRED (\$4,500.00) DOLLARS as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

Sec. 4. The Estimated Receipts from Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures are hereby increased by FORTY FIVE HUNDRED (\$4,500.00) Dollars.

Sec. 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.

SECTION 1: The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of Chapter 544, approved September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended, entitled "An Ordinance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height, and Area Regulations" is hereby amended by changing from an R-2 Two-family Zone to a C-1 Limited Commercial Zone, Lot 1 as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat 34; said lot being located at the junction of Manton and Chalkstone Avenues, and designated as 897 Manton Avenue, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the northerly line of Manton Avenue at the southeasterly corner of Lot 1 on Assessor's Plat 34; thence westerly along the said northerly line of Manton Avenue to the tangent point of a curve; thence westerly, northerly, and easterly in the arc of said curve to the tangent point of said curve in the southerly line of Chalkstone Avenue; thence continuing easterly along the said southerly line of Chalkstone Avenue to the northeasterly corner of Lot 1; thence southerly along the westerly line of Lot 2 to Manton Avenue and the point and place of beginning.

SEC. 2: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.



SUBJECT: REFERRAL NO. 670 - ZONING CHANGE AT 897 MANTON AVENUE

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Wednesday, December 15, 1954.

This referral is a request for a change in zoning from an R-2 Zone to a C-1 Zone of Lot 1 on Assessor's Plat 34 located at the junction of Manton and Chalkstone Avenues, and containing 2,920 square feet.


On the field trip it was noted that the petitioner's lot is now occupied by billboards. The only adjoining property contains a structure which is used as a residence and as an ice cream manufacturing plant. The neighboring properties are almost exclusively residences.

The introduction of a 2,920 square foot C-1 Zone here in an area which is primarily residential would be most undesirable, and would constitute a case of spot zoning. Therefore,








ZONING CHANGE NO.



is the owner of Lot 375 on Plat 78 of the City Assessor.


That said Lot is presently zoned in part M-1, in



SUBJECT: REFERRAL NO. 696 - ZONING CHANGE ON VEAZIE STREET

Gentlemen:

The subject referral received consideration by the City Plan Commission at a meeting held on Tuesday, April 12, 1955.

This referral is a request for a change in zoning of those portions of Lot 375 on Assessor's Plat 78 that are R-1 and R-2 to M-1. The lot in question is located on the westerly side of Veazie Street at the junction of Beulah and Veazie Streets with an area of 11 3/4 acres.

On the field trip it was found that the area in question is fenced for the storage of construction equipment. Extensive grading has been started on the lot. Directly across the street there is a 2 to 1 grade extending approximately ten feet above street level. No homes in this area front on Veazie Street.

In view of the precipitous nature of surrounding topography it does not seem likely that residential structures will be built on adjacent property. The change of zoning on this lot should not adversely affect the immediately adjoining and adjacent residential properties.


