COUNCILWOMAN CAROLYN F. BRASSIL, Chairwoman COMMITTEE ON FINANCE

Transmits the Following with Recommendation of Passage the First Time:

An Ordinance Providing for the Assessment and Collection of 1980 Taxes in a Sum Not Less than Seventy-Four Million Dollars (\$74,000,000.00) and Not More than Seventy-Six Million Dollars (\$76,000,000.00) being based on One Hundred Percent (100%) of the 1980-1981 Fiscal Year Tax Collection.
