RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

No. 739

Approved October 29, 1993

WHEREAS, Section 17-125 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Providence provides, viz.: "No city employee shall be allowed to buy back time for pension purposes without the express approval of the City Council, with the exception of purchasing military service," and

WHEREAS, Said Section 17-125 was a duly approved Ordinance which was in full force and effect until its repeal by Chapter 1993-28 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence approved September 24, 1993, and

WHEREAS, Prior to repeal of said Section 17-125 there were applications for the purchase of service credit, so-called buy backs, in the Employee Retirement System pending action by the City Council pursuant to said Section 17-125.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That said applications for the purchase of service credit in the Employee Retirement System, so-called buy backs, are hereby disapproved as follows:
