Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. The Zoning Map accompanying and made a part of
Chapter 544 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, approved
September 21, 1951, as heretofore amended, and entitled "An Ordin-
ance Zoning the City of Providence and Establishing Use, Height
and Area Regulations", is hereby further amended by changing from
a C-4 Heavy Commercial Zone to an M-1 General Industrial Zone, Lots
numbered 1 and 2, as set out and delineated on City Assessor's Plat
77, and lots numbered 147, 148, 149, 150, 151, 152, 153, 163, 164,
165, 166, 167, and 168, as set out and delineated on City Assessor's
Plat 72; said lots being situated generally within that area bounded
by the westerly side of Silver Spring Street, the southerly side of
Ledge Street and the easterly side of Edward Street, bounded and
described as follows:

Beginning at the southwesterly corner of Silver Spring and
Ledge streets at the northeasterly corner of Lot 1 on City Asses-
sor's Plat 77; thence southerly along the westerly line of Silver
Spring Street to the southeasterly corner of Lot 163 on Assessor's
Plat 72; thence westerly along the northerly line of Lot 162 to
the southwesterly corner of Lot 163; thence southerly along the
westerly line of Lot 162 to the southeasterly corner of Lot 153;
thence westerly along the northerly line of Lot 154 to the easterly
line of Edward Street at the southwesterly corner of Lot 153;
thence northerly along the easterly line of Edward Street to the
northwesterly corner of Lot 147; thence easterly along the southerly
lines of Lots 3 and 4 on Assessor's Plat 77 to the southwesterly
corner of Lot 2 on Plat 77; thence northerly along the easterly line
of Lot 3 to the southerly line of Ledge Street at the northwesterly
corner of Lot 2; thence easterly along the southerly line of Ledge
Street to the southwesterly corner of Ledge and Silver Spring streets
at the northeasterly corner of Lot 1 on Plat 77 and the point and
place of beginning.

This referral is a petition to change the zoning from C-4 (heavy commercial) to M-1 (general industrial) Lots 1 and 2 on Assessor's Plat 77 and Lots 149, 150, 152, 153, 163, 164, 165, 166, 167 and 168 on Assessor's Plat 72.

On an inspection and photographic survey it was determined that the land in question is vacant except for a used car agency on Lots 152 and 163. The adjoining residential property on Ledge Street and Edward Street is in very good condition.

Attention is directed to:

Referrals #800 and 800A dated 8/12/56 in which the same petitioner requested a change in zoning on the same property from R-3 to C-4. The City Plan Commission recommended denial and warned of further encroachment. The City Council took no action.

Referral No. 1358 dated 3/4/64. The same petitioner again requested a zoning change from R-3 to C-4. The City Plan Commission again recommended denial. The City Council took no action.

Referral No. 1436 dated 4/26/65. The same petitioner again requested a zoning change from R-3 to C-4. The City Plan Commission offered no objection and the change was made by the City Council.

The residential property on land adjacent to this property is in very good condition and would be adversely affected by further industrialization in the





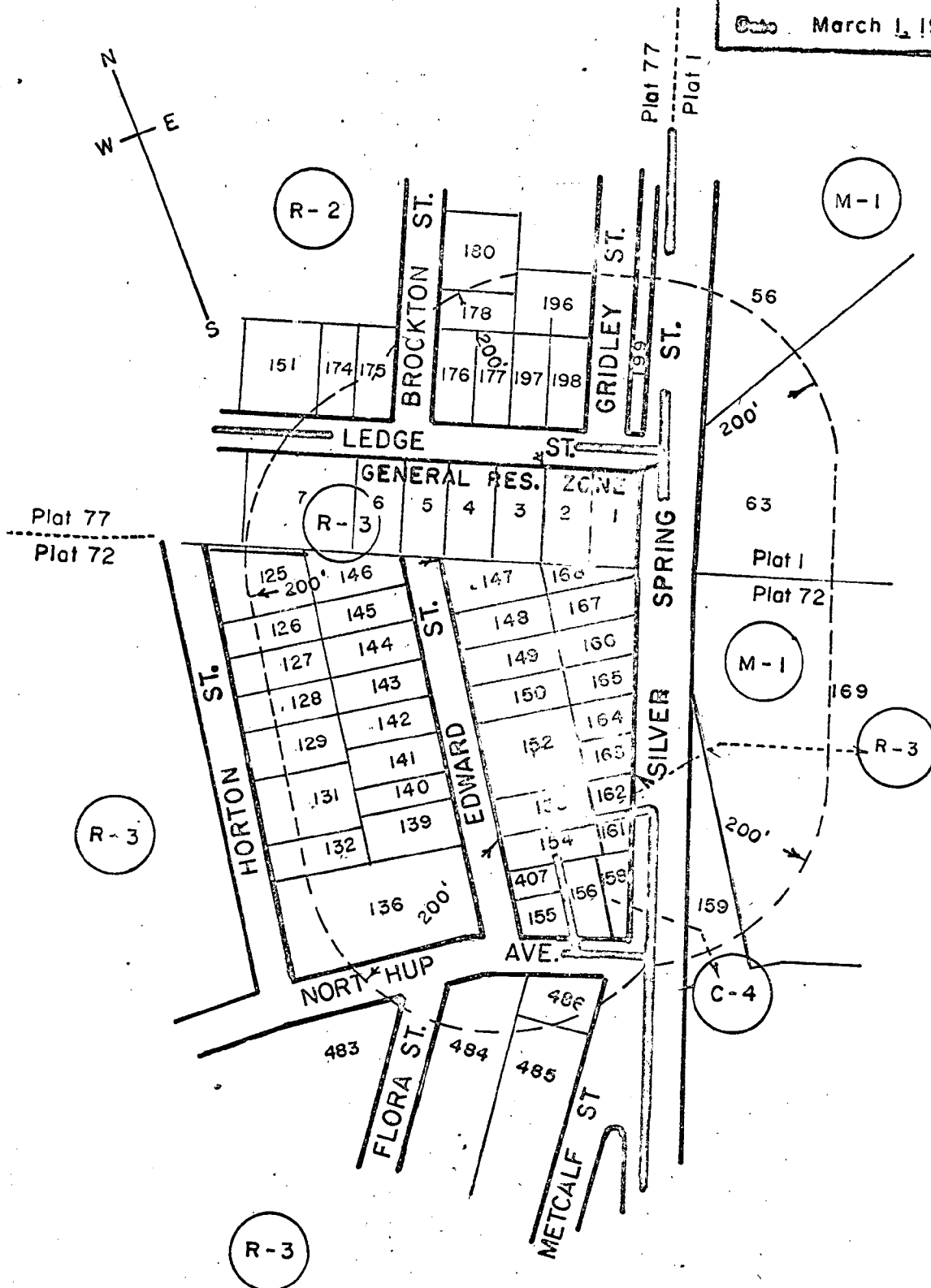

If there is any question concerning this proposal, feel free to confer with me at City Hall.



CHAPTER 33-27

No. 209 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AUTHORIZATION OF REWARDS NOT TO EXCEED FIVE HUNDRED (\$500) DOLLARS BY HIS HONOR THE MAYOR FOR THE APPREHENSION AND CONVICTION OF ANY PERSON MALICIOUSLY DESTROYING OR DEFACING CITY PROPERTY.

Approved July 10, 1968

Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 23 of SECTION 3 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES of the City of Providence, 1946 is hereby amended by adding the following language:

"The Mayor of the City of Providence is hereby authorized to offer a suitable reward, not to exceed the sum of FIVE HUNDRED (\$500) DOLLARS in any one case, for any information leading to the detection, apprehension and conviction of any offender or offenders who maliciously destroy or deface City property.

"Said reward shall be paid by the City Treasurer upon the order of the City Controller, and said City Controller shall draw said order for payment whenever he shall receive a certificate of final conviction from the Justice or Clerk of the Court before which said offender or offenders were tried."

SEC. 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
