Sponsor of Resolution No. 663 is Councilman Edward W. Xavier and sponsor of Resolution No. 664 is Councilman Philip A. Almagno.



With reference to your letter dated November 3, and Resolutions Nos. 663 and 664, passed by the Providence City Council on October 16, and approved by Mayor Vincent A. Cianci, Jr. on October 24, regarding bus shelters being placed in front of Our Lady of Fatima Council, located along Gano Street; in front of the Multi-Purpose Center on Plainfield Street; and along Pocasset Avenue, Hartford Avenue and Plainfield Street, please be advised that the Rhode Island Public Transit Authority entered into a contract with Public Transit Shelters, Inc., for the construction and maintenance of 150 transit shelters, to be erected throughout the State on all RIPTA routes.

We have forwarded your requests to our contractor for consideration, and should this location meet our criteria, we will recommend construction.
