### RESOLVED, DECREED AND ORDERED

That the following named street shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan entitled "Providence, Rhode Island, P.W. Dept. - Engineering Office, City Property Section Plan No. 064172, dated December 31, 1981",

### VIZ:

Oriental Street, to abandon as a public highway the entire width of that certain portion of Oriental Street, running in a general southerly direction from its intersection with the State Highway Line established on Admiral Street, a distance of five hundred (500) feet, more or less to a point which point is the southeasterly point of property owned by Admiral Associates and the northeasterly point of property owned by National Biscuit Co., said width of said Oriental Street is Forty (40) feet, more or less, shown as cross-hatched area on the accompanying plan and designated by the letters (A-B-C-D-A), having ceased to be useful to the public and is proposed to be abandoned as a Public Highway, subject to the petitioner conveying easements acceptable to the following: to relocate the 12" water line which is located in Oriental Street at petitioner's expense; Narragansett Electric Company be permitted the retention of their facilities in existing locations, together with the right to inspect, maintain, operate and replace the same; and the damage to the abutters is appraised at nothing and so awarded, and it is further

ORDERED, That the Director of Public Works be and he is hereby directed to cause a sign to be placed on the above-named highway abandoned as aforesaid, having thereon the words, "Not a Public Highway", and it is further

ORDERED, That after the entry of this order or decree the City Clerk shall cause a notice thereof to be published in a newspaper published in the County of Providence at least once a week for three successive weeks and a further and personal notice shall be served by the City Sergeant upon every owner of land abutting the above-named highway which has been abandoned, who is known to reside within the State.

The following will serve to confirm our December 16, 1981, conversation relative to the abandonment of a portion of Oriental Street in the City of Providence.

On October 5, 1963, this Department made it's first land acquisition for the Louisquisset Pike Connector by virtue of condemnation of Plat No. 1305. This land taking included a portion of Oriental Street near and including Admiral Street.

On April 30, 1970, by virtue of Plat No. 1590, this Department made the second land taking for the Louisquisset Pike Connector which included a portion of Oriental Street about 300 feet southwest of Admiral Street.

Between that taking by Plat No. 1305 and Plat No. 1590, is a portion of Oriental Street which still is owned by the City of Providence. It is this portion of said street that the abutter has asked be abandoned.

Gentlemen:

This is in response to the December 8, 1981 memorandum from the Committee on Public Works requesting comment on the petition to abandon the entire width of that portion of Oriental Street from Admiral Street (service road) running southerly for a distance of five hundred (500) feet to a point which is the southeasterly point of Lot 776 on Assessor's Plat 68. The aforesaid petition was submitted by Union Industries, Inc., 10 Admiral Street, was introduced into the City Council by the City Clerk on December 3, 1981, and was referred to the Committee on Public Works for further study.

A field inspection by this Department revealed that Oriental Street was a 40 foot wide improved public right-of-way which runs southerly from Admiral Street to Oregon Street; that its middle portion was abandoned and has become part of R. I. State highway land; and that Oriental Street has effectively become two dead-end streets. (See attached map).

According to the description of the portion of Oriental Street in the petition, the above cited State land that is now used for parking is incorrectly included for abandonment.

The only portion of Oriental Street that is a City street and can be abandoned runs southerly approximately 250 feet in length from Admiral Street, actually a service road, to its terminus along the easterly property line of Lot 776, which is owned by the petitioner-Union Paper Co. Inc., and which occupies an industrial complex on the lot.



The aforesaid 250 foot portion of Oriental Street has no importance as a public street, but is a service road to the petitioner's industrial complex. The abandonment of this portion of said street should not negatively affect the traffic circulation within this area, or, that of any property other than that of the petitioner.

Therefore, the Department of Planning and Urban Development will recommend to the City Plan Commission at its January 6, 1982 meeting that it advise the Committee on Public Works that no objection should be offered on this petition for the abandonment of the 250 foot portion of Oriental Street running southerly from Admiral Street. The City Plan Commission will advise the Committee of its action on the petition immediately after its January 6th meeting.

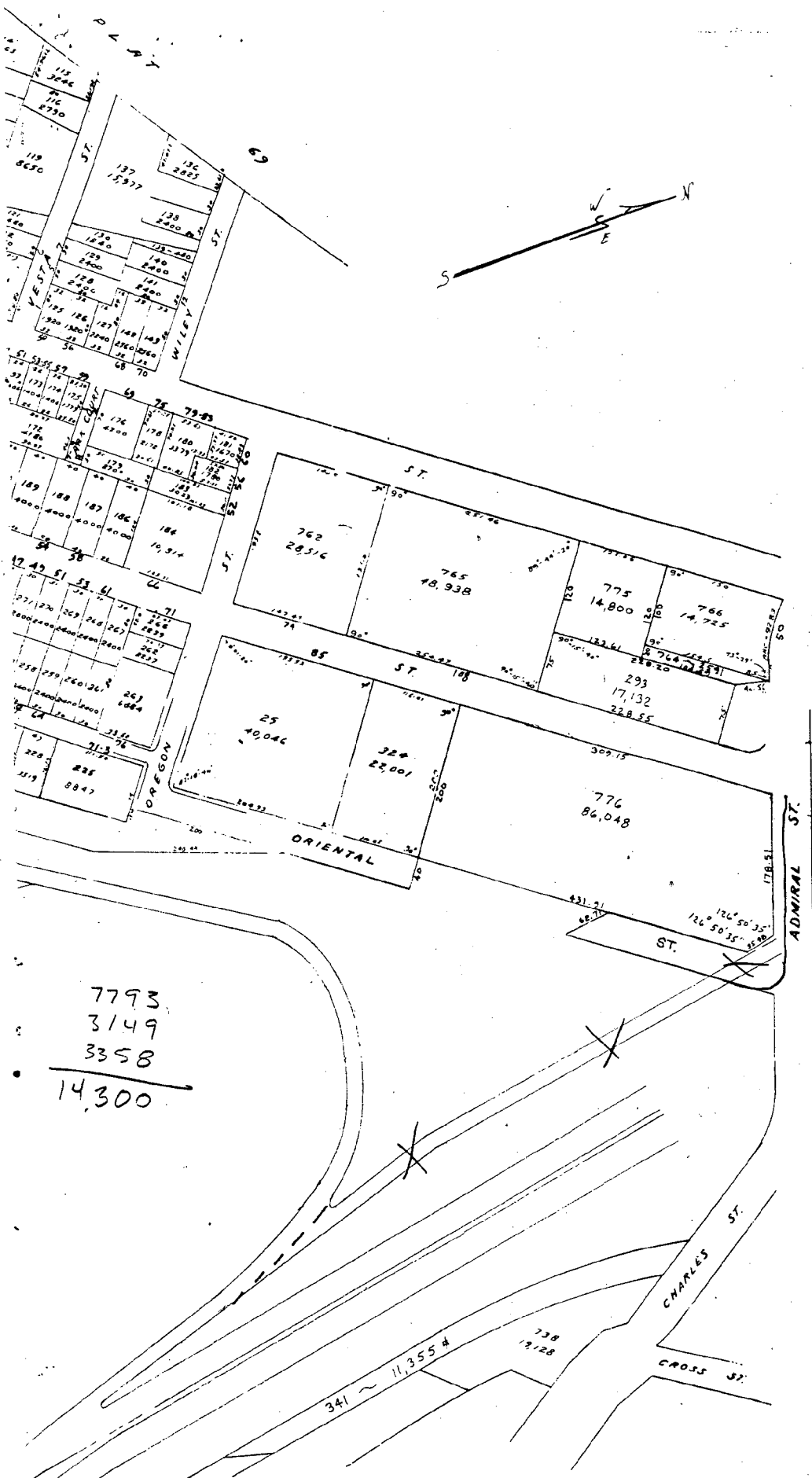


