TO THE HONORABLE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE:


The undersigned respectfully petitions your honorable body


Together, we, Steven Boudreau and John Rector, Owners of The Groceria, Inc., a new market and cafe located at 159 Weybosset St. in the Arts and Entertainment District, hereby petition your honorable body for permission to terminate exhaust from our small prep kitchen facility into the alley located directly behind our storefront as opposed to running ductwork to the roof line of the 4 story building, a very costly project.

The alley currently known as Middle Street, runs from Eddy Street, near the old "Peanut Store" to Union St. directly in front of the Travelers Aid Society. The alley is used primarily for access to our dumpster and we have personally taken on the efforts of maintaining the cleanliness of the alley in an effort to present a clean atmosphere surrounding our storefront. Currently, many individuals utilize the alley as a bathroom facility and twice a day we clean liquor bottles and debris from the street.

In seeking this variance we point out that all other codes with regard to exhaust termination can be met and proper distances will be kept between property lines etc. Fire Marshal David Costa has been to the site and these projects have been discussed and approved by him contingent on approval by The Honorable City Council.


