**No. 417**      **AN ORDINANCE** AMENDING CHAPTER 14 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES ENTITLED "LICENSES," SECTION 14-95

*Approved* JULY 26, 2007

***Be it ordained by the City of Providence:***

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of

Providence is hereby amended in part to read as follows:

**Sec. 14-95. Same--Fees.**

Each applicant for a stationary engineer, boiler operator, apprentice boiler operator, or refrigeration engineer license, and each application for renewal shall pay to the director, at the time of application, the following fee:

Stationary engineer.....	\$50.00	\$40.00—
Boiler operator.....	40.00	30.00—
Apprentice boiler operator.....	20.00	20.00—
Refrigeration machine operator.....	40.00	30.00—

*Amending Section 14-95*    **Professional License Fees**

License fees (engineer, boiler, refrigeration) were set in 1993. All others were changed in 2002. License fees earn approximately \$93,542. **Raising fees 25% would earn an additional \$23,358/yr.** These fees are set by ordinance §14-95.
