Professionally led the administration and operation of an eight-division department with 50 employees and an annual operating budget of \$5.5 million. Planned, improved and maintained all infrastructure for a town of 35,000 in a 64 square mile area with over 200 miles of roads. Developed and executed the annual operating budget and five-year Capital Improvements Program. Supervised Public Works personnel, developed a variety of programs, provided direction and discipline, and worked well with the union to resolve grievances and develop departmental policies. Reported directly to the Town Manager in Council/Manager form of government. In addition:

- Coordinated the implementation of a \$16 million Fast Track Sewer Project involving three communities, a major pharmaceutical firm, the Governor's office and EDC.
- Provided oversight for three contractors working simultaneously to bring a 5 mile pipeline and pumping station into service on time. Served as the Town's sewer department, outlining future projects, and processed all payment requisitions.
- Worked with numerous State and Federal agencies including RIDOT, RIDEM, EPA, and FEMA in the application for and administration of grants for wooden bridges, public education, purchasing of materials, senior center conversion, and water main installation.
- Served at the Executive level of the Town's Emergency Operations Center.
- Maintained bridge inventory and developed annual bridge maintenance program from State inspection reports.
- Provided professional engineering design for all Town projects, design review for all subdivisions and State DOT projects, and site plan review for commercial construction.
- Worked with a consultant to inspect Town facilities and operations to ensure Environmental Compliance under EPA self-audit program.
- Developed an ongoing pavement management program using the Micropaver program, and developed an annual Road Resurfacing Program that lasted 20 years.
- Developed bid documents and technical specifications for all municipal construction projects, service contracts, and all major Public Works purchases.
- Collaborated with RIDEM to implement recommended improvements under State Dam Safety program.

- Served as the primary liaison for the Landfill Closure Group, a committee of 15 PRP's participating in the development of plans to properly close and remediate an old town dump. Worked closely with attorneys, environmental experts, land owners, investigators, and RIDEM. Developed solicitation and selected consultants, reviewed drafts, kept Town officials informed.
- Developed detention basin design standards, subdivision construction standards and details, draft and obtain drainage agreements, review drainage designs and calculations, and met with residents to resolve drainage problems. Administered NFIP through flood map maintenance.
- Served as an advisor to the Planning Commission in reviewing subdivisions.
- Developed construction cost estimates for subdivisions for use in bond establishment and outstanding work cost estimates for bond reduction requests.
- Assisted in the development of the Town's Soil Erosion ordinance and the Coordinated street numbering for E-911. Designed new and replacement ISDS for several Town facilities and implementation thereof.
- Coordinated the asbestos abatement program for all non-educational municipal facilities.
- Reviewed applications to the Zoning Board with respect to engineering and Public Works considerations.
- Coordinated the work of a consultant in the development of a Sewer Facilities Plan Update.
- Reviewed the traffic analysis and studies prepared for various subdivisions and state road improvements. Served on the Town's Traffic Advisory Committee.
- Processed all sewer connection applications and licensed contractor applications. Identified sources of funding for ongoing and future sewer work.
- Updated and revised the Town's ordinance for streets and sidewalks.
- Assisted in the defense in a construction arbitration lawsuit. Reviewed sewer connection plans and applications and maintained connection list to the out-of-town regional facility.
- Attended all Planning Commission meetings, Sewer Subcommittee, Traffic Advisory Committee and every budget meeting.
- Attended most Town Council meetings, and frequent Zoning Board meetings.
- Coordinated the Public Works emergency planning and response for winter storms and hurricanes.
- Administered the development, implementation and expansion of a curbside recycling program, yard waste collection, and transfer station. Coordinated work of contractor operating transfer station and hauling to State landfill. Recommended improvements in sanitation collection to the Town Council and developed means to educate the public.
- Met regularly with insurance inspectors to maintain safety in Town facilities and directed work to meet recommendations.
- Worked with the Town's Finance Director to develop an inventory of Town infrastructure to meet the requirements of GASB 34.
- Developed an Onsite Wastewater Management Plan so that residents will be eligible for low interest loans for emergency repairs.
