Be it ordained by the City of Providence:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1788 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, as approved September 26, 1966, and entitled: "An Ordinance Making Appropriation of \$47,405,335.25 for the Support of the City Government for the Fiscal Year Ending September 30, 1967", as amended, is hereby further amended by appropriating the sum of Seventy Seven Thousand (\$77,000) Dollars to the FIRE DEPARTMENT, ITEM 0.

SECTION 2. The said sum of Seventy Seven Thousand (\$77,000) Dollars as thus added and appropriated shall be obtained by authorizing and directing the City Controller and City Treasurer to transfer a like amount from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account to the Receipt Account.

SECTION 3. The estimated receipts from the Reserve for Extraordinary Expenditures Account are hereby increased by Seventy Seven Thousand (\$77,000) Dollars.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
