It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 47-8-1 of the General Laws in Chapter 47-8
2 entitled "Gasoline and Petroleum Products" is hereby amended to read
3 as follows:

4 47-8-1. Testing of measuring devices -- Forbidding use -- Fee.
5 -- The director of labor is hereby authorized and directed to have
6 tested all gasoline measuring devices used in the sale of gasoline,
7 from time to time, as in his or her judgment it may be deemed neces-
8 sary, to prevent fraud or deception in the use of these devices or to
9 insure the accurate measurement of gasoline in the sale. Any town or
10 city sealer of weights, measures, and balances shall have authority to
11 condemn and forbid the use of any gasoline measuring device for the
12 sale of gasoline in his respective town or city, or until the device
13 has been duly tried and sealed, or until the gasoline measuring device
14 has been equipped with such an attachment, contrivance, or apparatus
15 as will insure the correct and proper functioning of the measuring
16 device for the sale of the gasoline by accurate measurement. For the
17 testing and sealing of a gasoline measuring device, a fee of three

1 dollars (\$3.00) shall be paid unless otherwise stated in section
2 47-1-5.1, except in the city of Providence where the fee shall be fif-
3 teen dollars (\$15.00) and the sealer shall have the authority to
4 remove and replace any lead seal on any gasoline measuring device and
5 to charge an additional fee of ~~three-dollars-(\$3.00)~~ five dollars
6 (\$5.00) for that service.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 44-34-4.1 of the General Laws in Chapter
2 44-34 entitled "Excise on motor Vehicles and Trailers" is hereby
3 amended to read as follows:

4 44-34-4.1. Exemptions for buses, trucks and trailers in inter-
5 state commerce. -- Notwithstanding any provision of the general laws
6 to the contrary the operation of a bus, truck, or trailer by a bus or
7 trucking company in interstate commerce shall not be subject to the
8 provisions of the excise tax imposed by this chapter, on the condition
9 that the bus, truck and/or trailer be utilized exclusively in inter-
10 state commerce, provided, however, buses, trucks and trailers regis-
11 tered in the city of Providence shall be ineligible for the exemption
12 granted by this section.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
